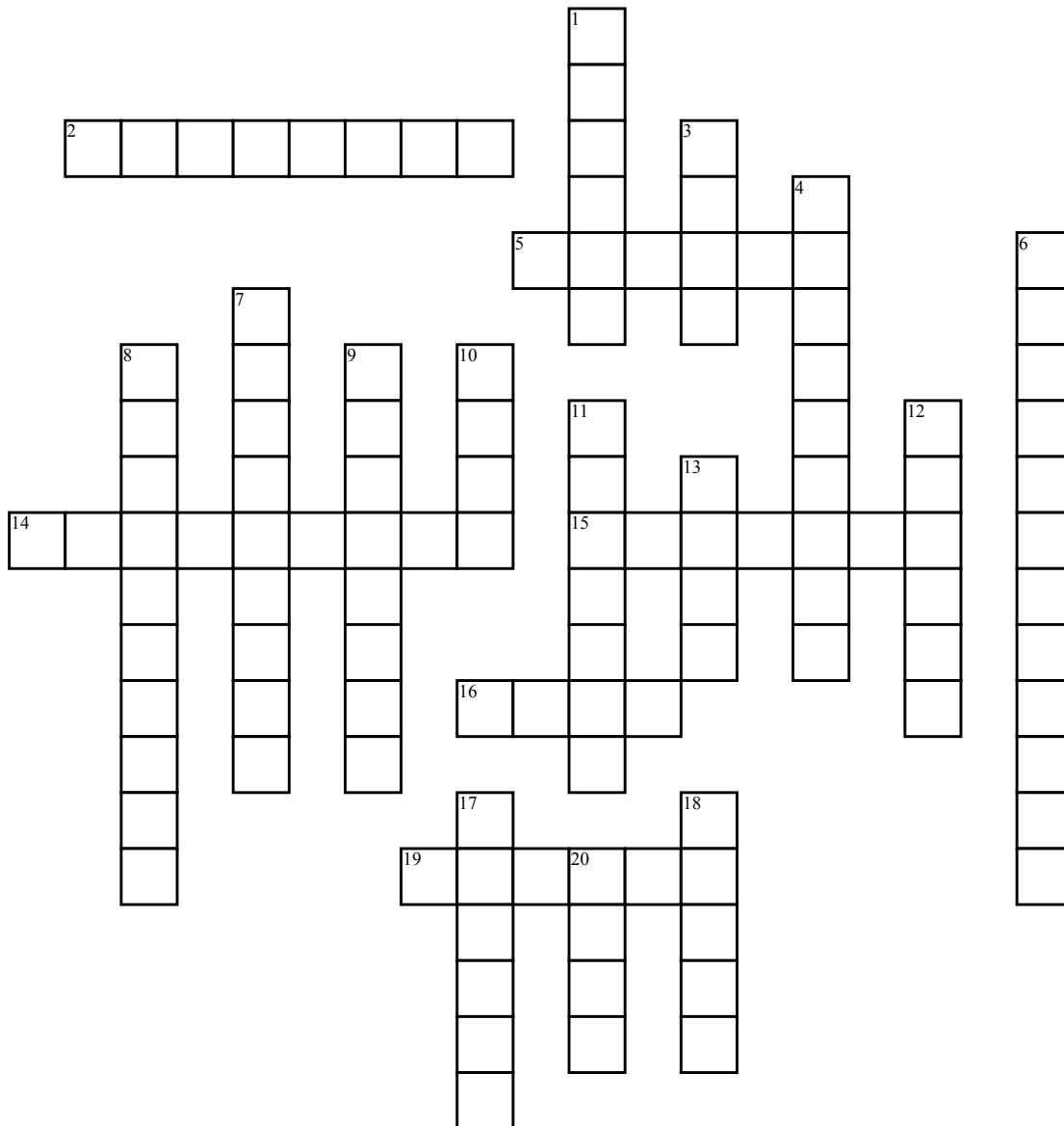


# Lyddie Vocabulary Crossword
