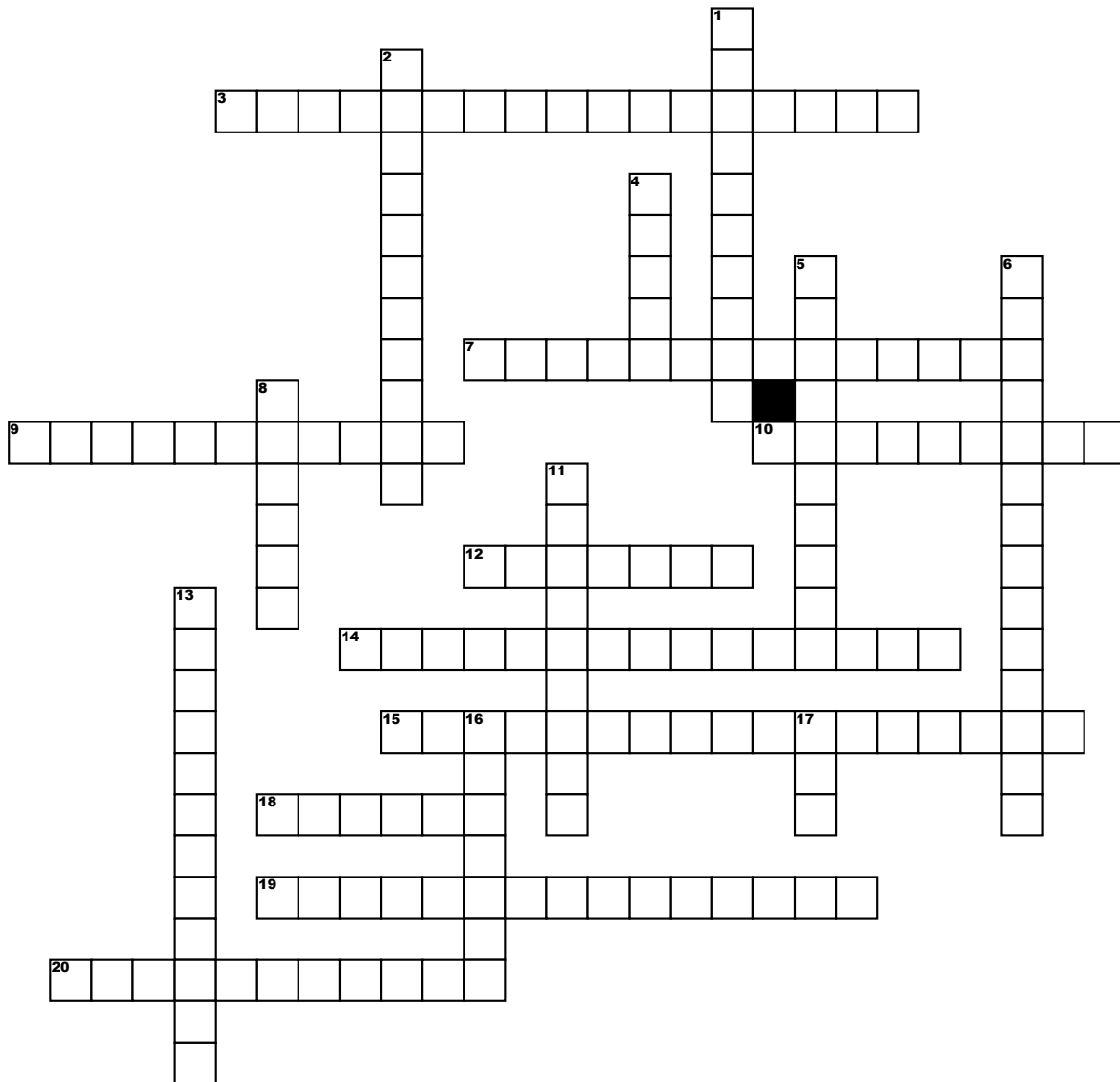


# Lymphatic System
