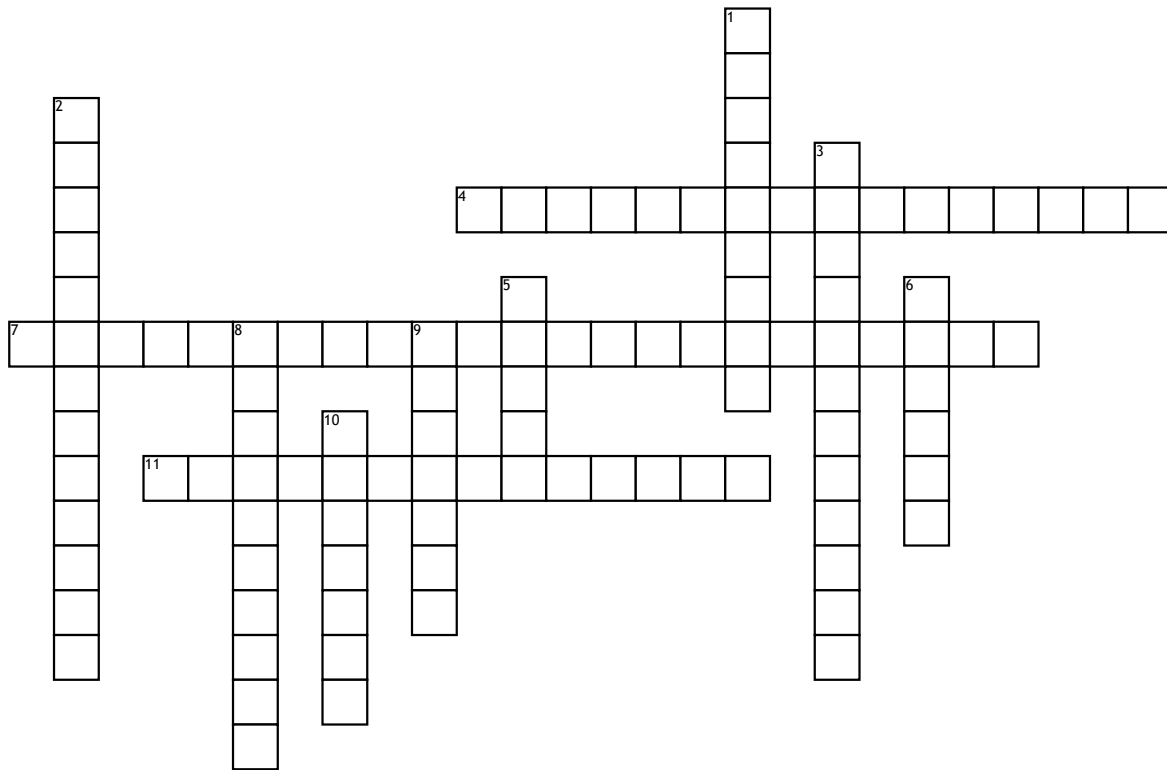


Lymphedema

4. allows for visualization of the content of the lymphatic system using a radiocontrast agent.
7. uses gentle skin massage with specific strokes and light pressure to promote the movement of lymph from areas of stagnation to areas of normal flow
11. presents as a scaly brown/gray patch of over-proliferated keratin

1. Lymphedema caused by an acquired impairment of the lymphatic system
2. is the enlargement and hardening of limbs or body parts due to tissue swelling present in stage 3 lymphedema
