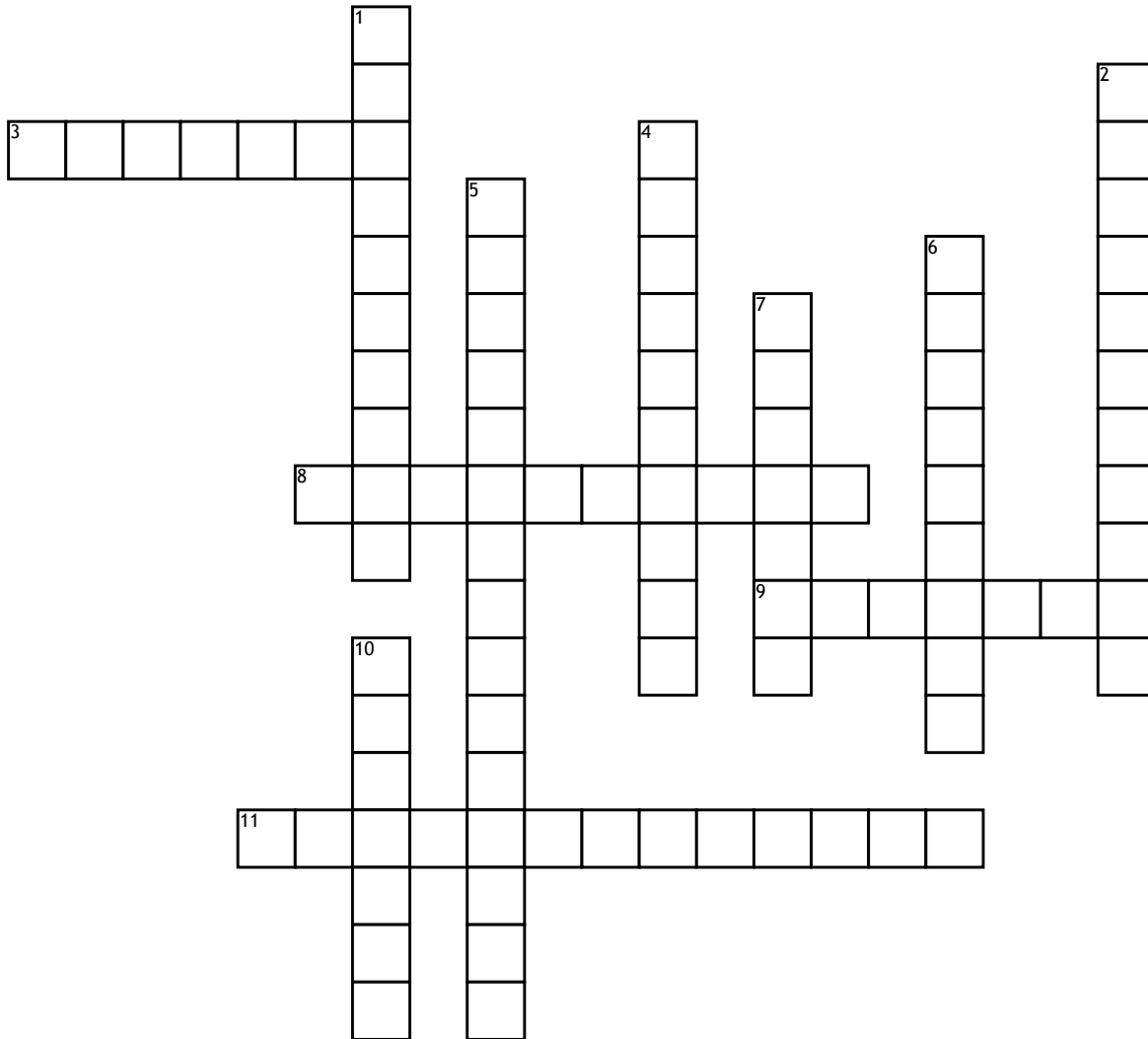


MERCANTILISM
