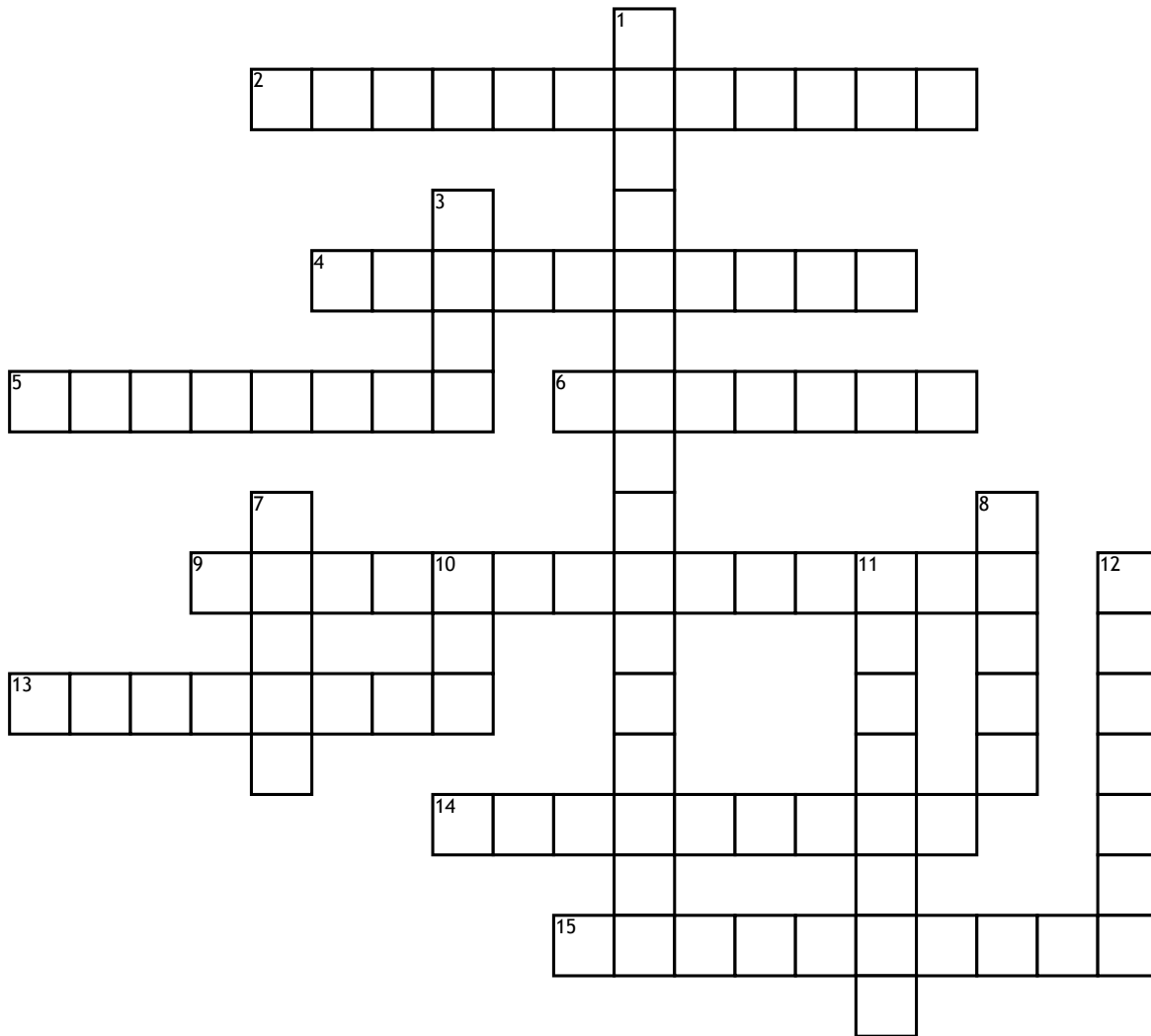


MICROSCOPE CROSSWORD

2. powerhouse of cells, converts glucose into ATP energy.
4. used to hold specimen for viewing.
5. connects the eyepiece to the objective lenses
6. storage for nutrients and water
9. Used for focus on oil. Moves the body tube for focusing the high power lense.

13. Can adjust the amount of light.

14. covers the specimen on a slide.

15. holds the slides into place

1. Used for focus on scanning. Usually the low power lens is used, enabling the movement of the tube.

3. the bottom of the microscope, used for support

7. a steady light source used in a place of a mirror.

8. the flat platform where you place your slides.

10. Supports the tube and it connects to the base.

11. the lens at the top that you look through, magnified 10x

12. control center of cells, contains DNA
