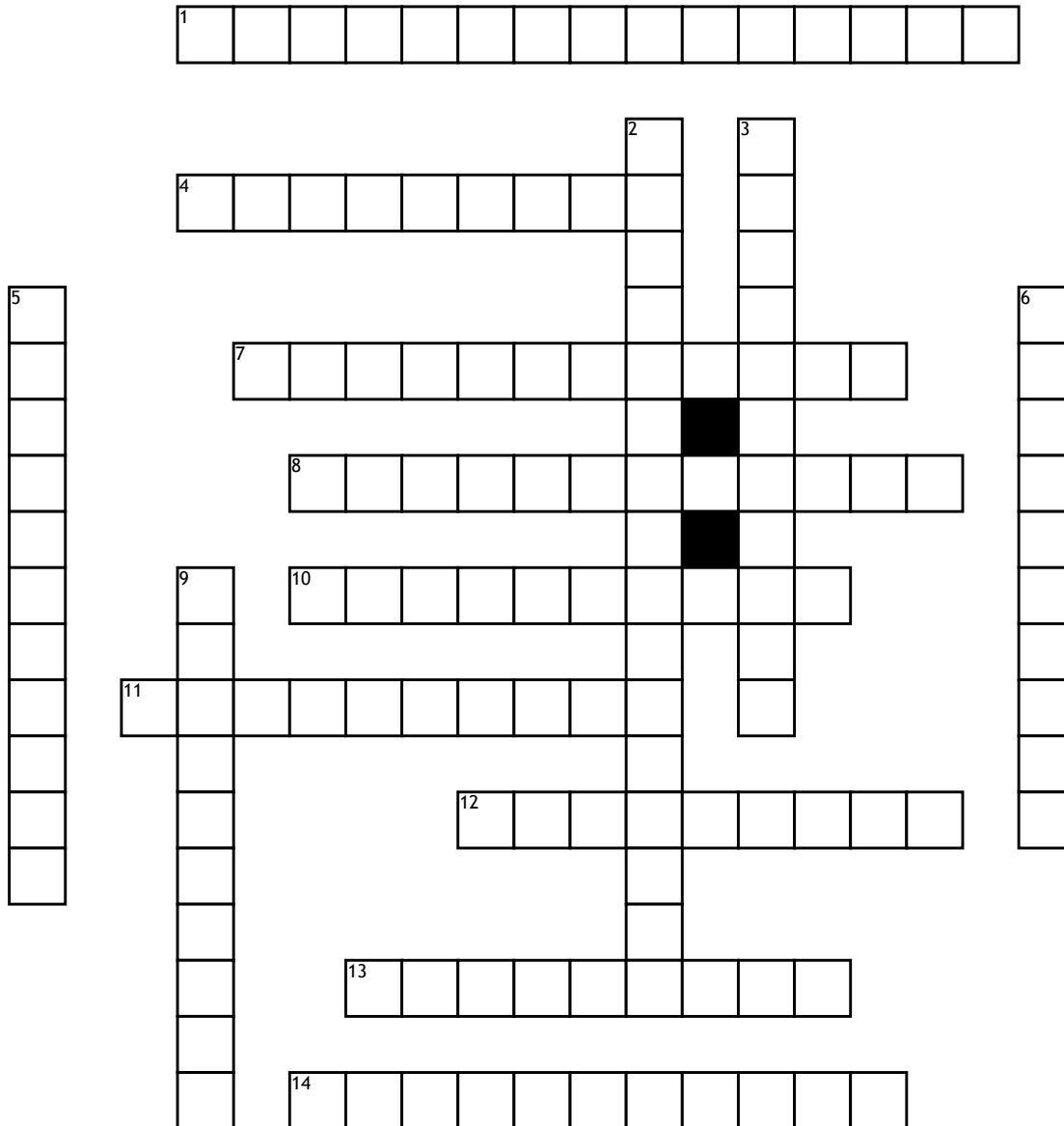


# MSK Introduction



## Across

1. a drug that can cause MSK disorders  
 4. an aneural tissue  
 7. immediate biological response to trauma  
 8. disorder of attachment of ligament or tendon to bone  
 10. age-related muscle loss

11. a common drug used for pain and inflammation  
 12. a chemical mediator that changes permeability  
 13. stored in bones  
 14. these resorb existing bone

2. these are needed for a sense of joint position

3. when WBCs migrate to periphery of a blood vessel  
 5. when WBCs adhere to walls of damaged capillary  
 6. a clotting mechanism formed in the liver  
 9. when blood vessels dilate allowing WBCs to squeeze through blood vessel wall
