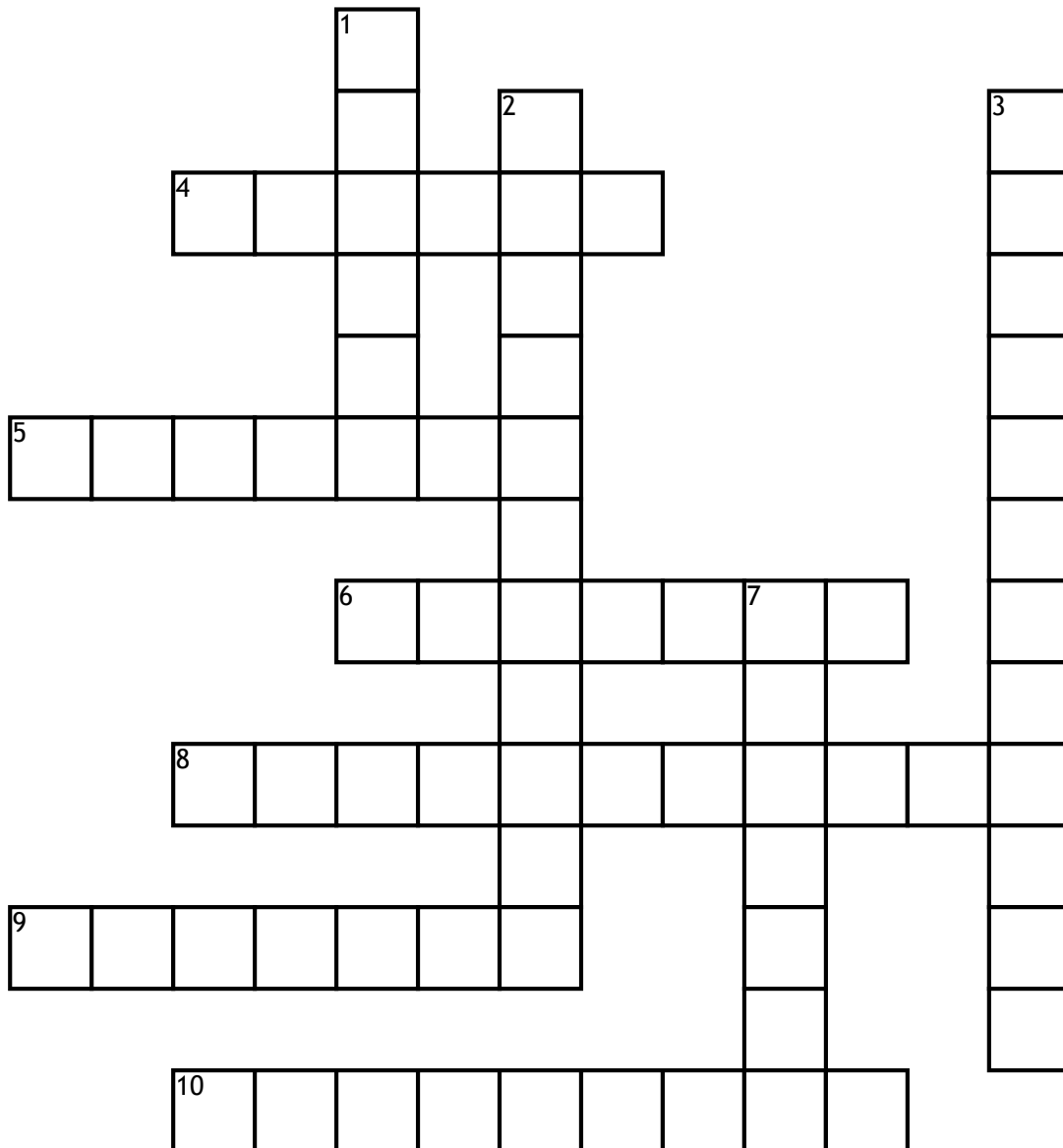


Macbeth: Cast of Characters
