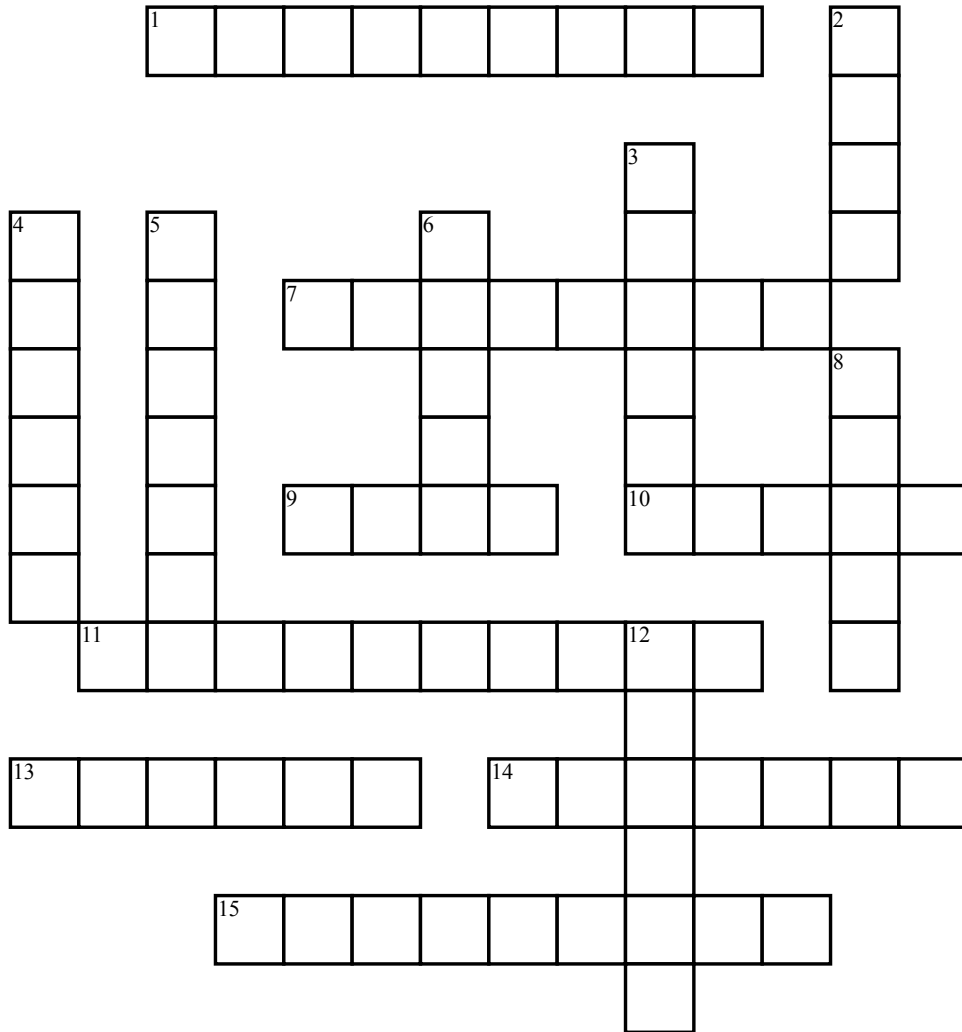


# Macbeth Crossword Puzzle
