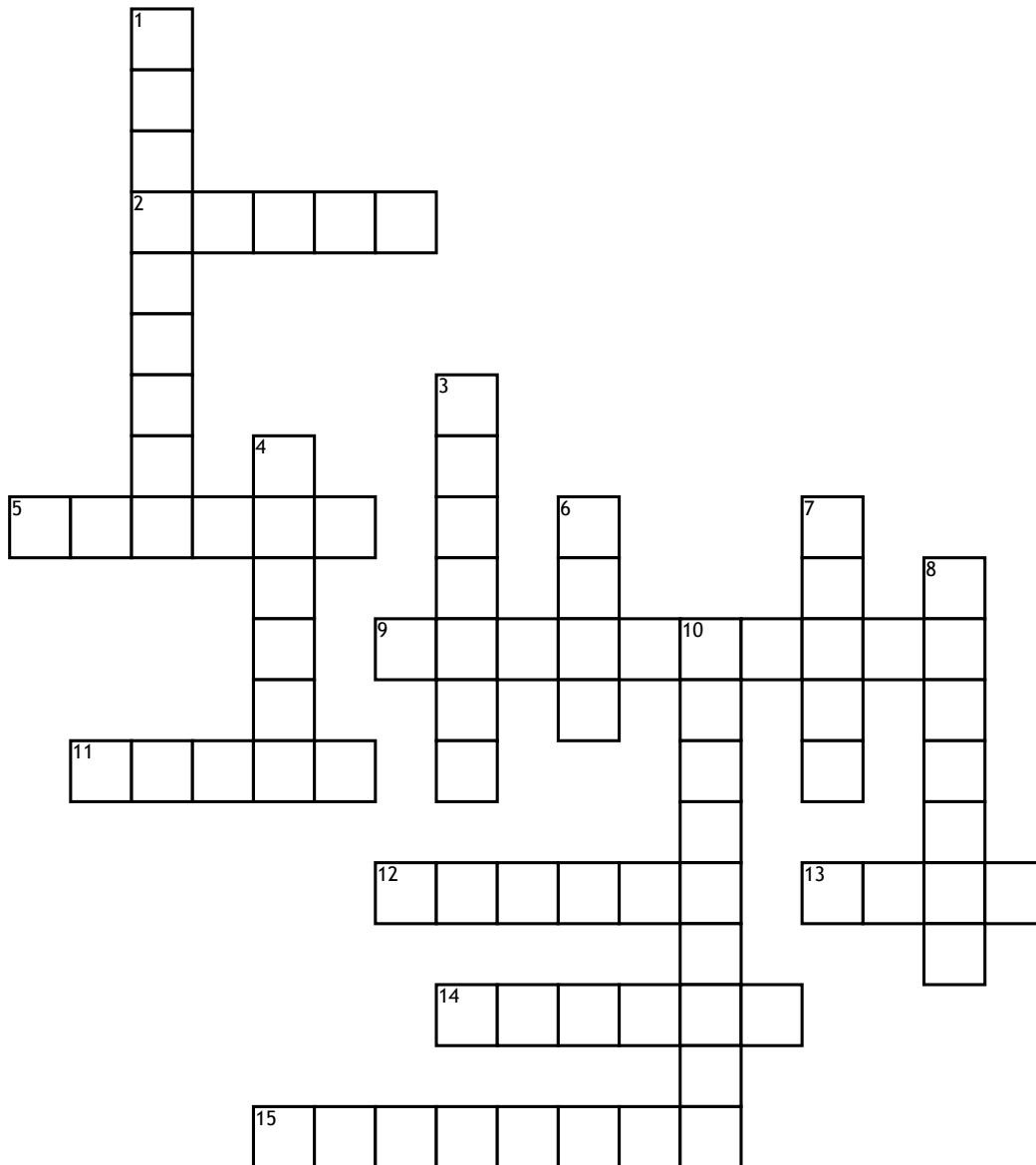


Macbeth Crossword Puzzle
