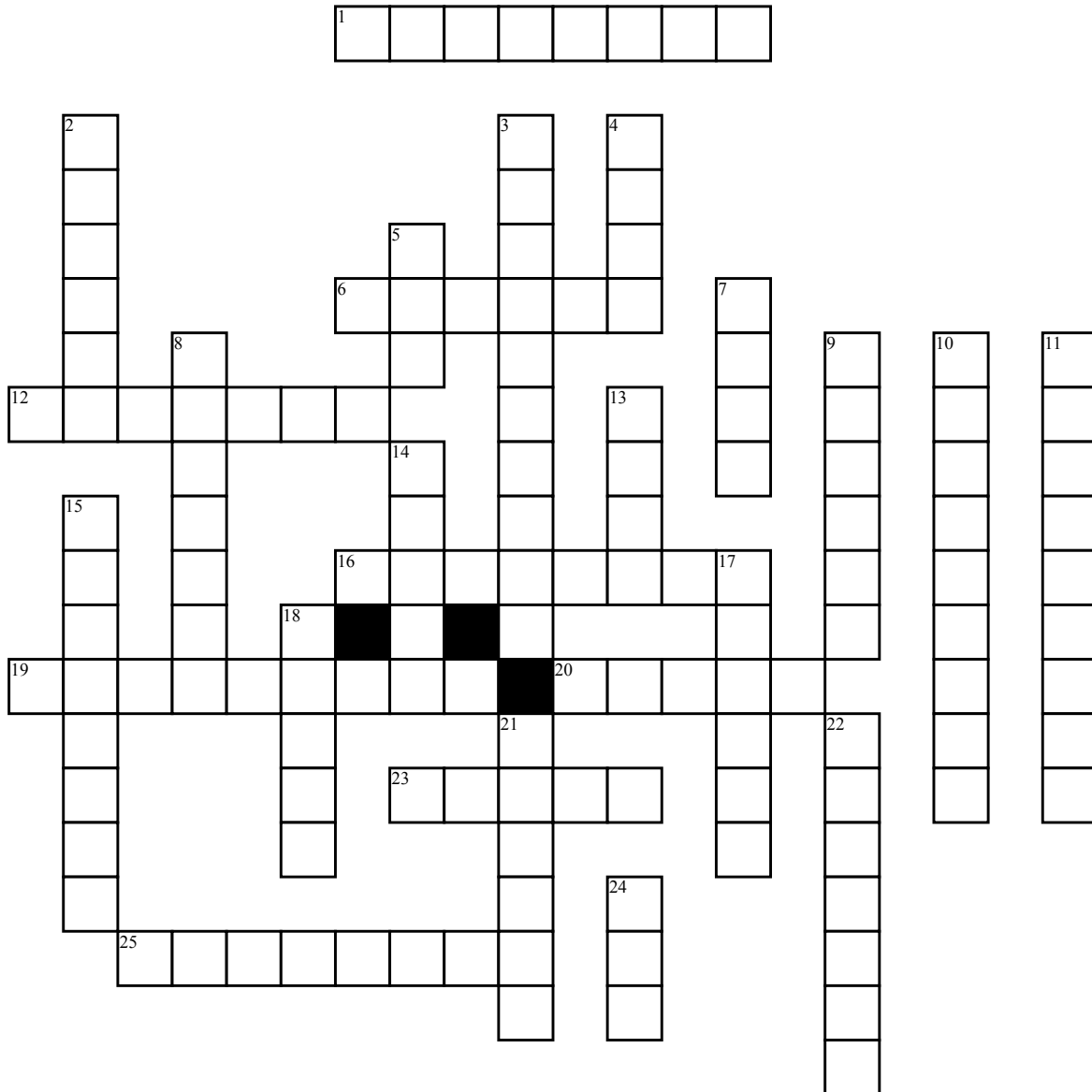


Macbeth Vocabulary crossword puzzle
