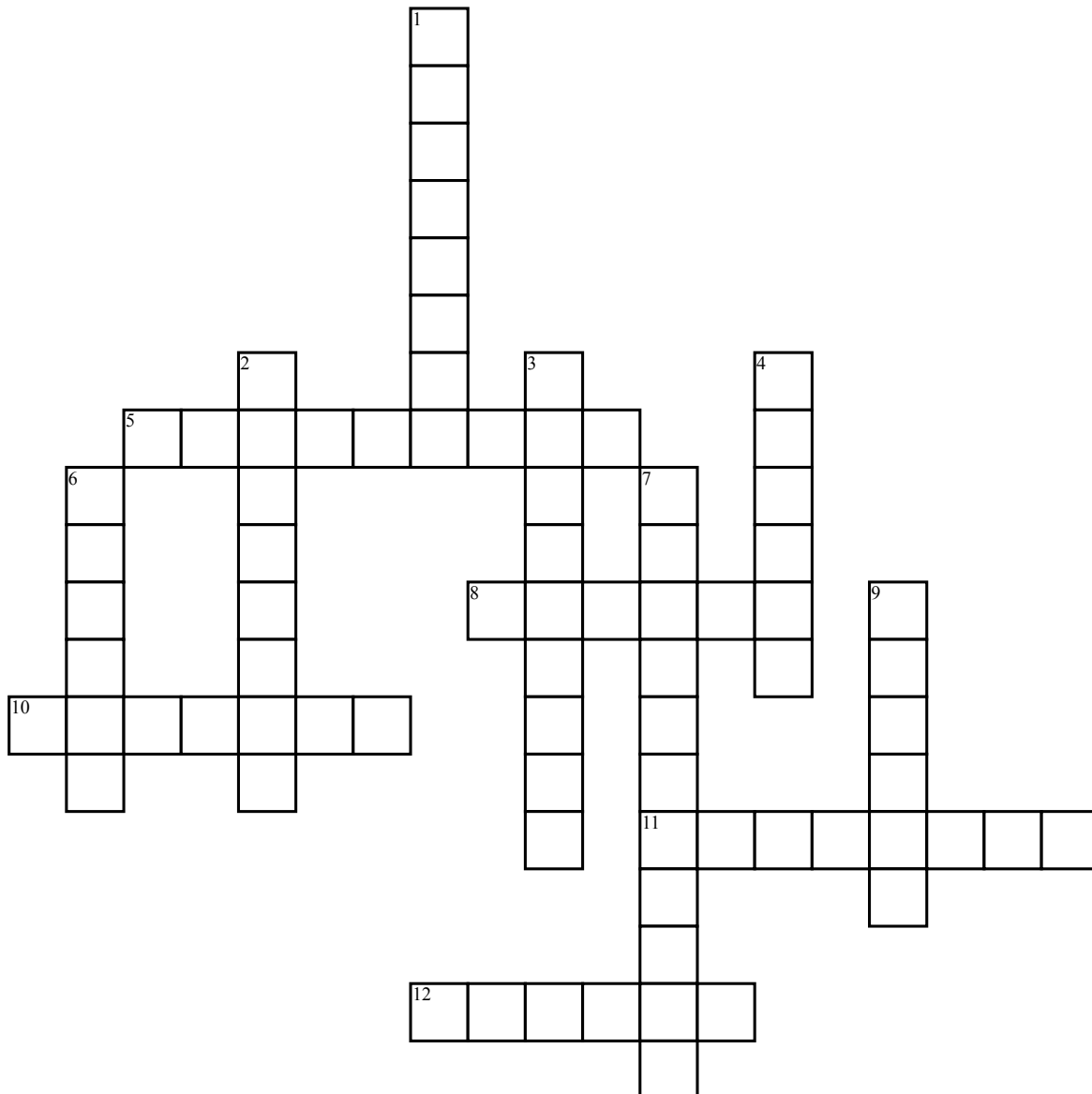


Macbeth acts 2 and 3
