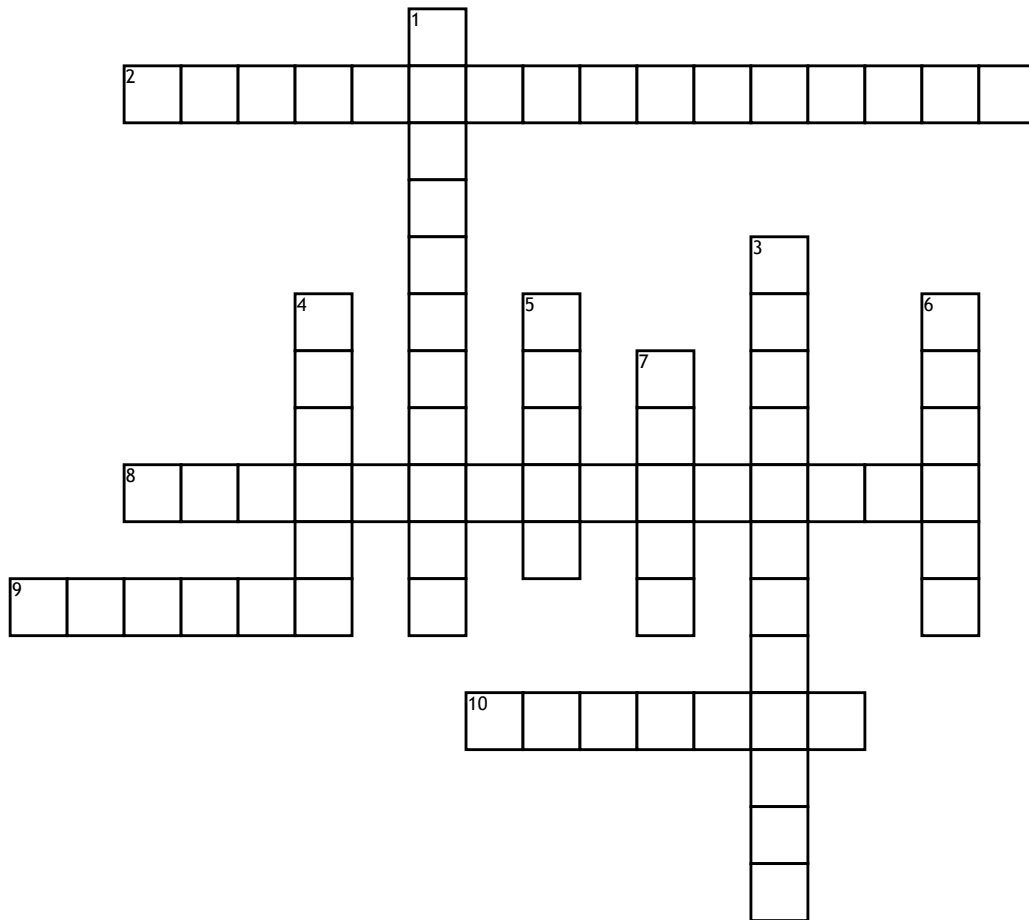


# Map and Globe Elements



## Across

- 2. imaginary vertical lines that measure the distance east or west of the prime meridian.
- 8. are imaginary horizontal lines that measure the distance north or south of the equator.
- 9. represent different kinds of information. For example, the color blue usually represents water.
- 10. represent information such as natural resources and economic activities.

## Down

- 1. shows the directions north, south, east, and west.
- 3. shows the specific area of the world that is shown on a map.
- 4. the names of places, such as cities, countries, rivers, and mountains.
- 5. shows how much distance on Earth is represented by distance on the map or globe.
- 6. or key. explains what the symbols and colors on the map or globe represent.
- 7. tells the subject of the map or globe.
