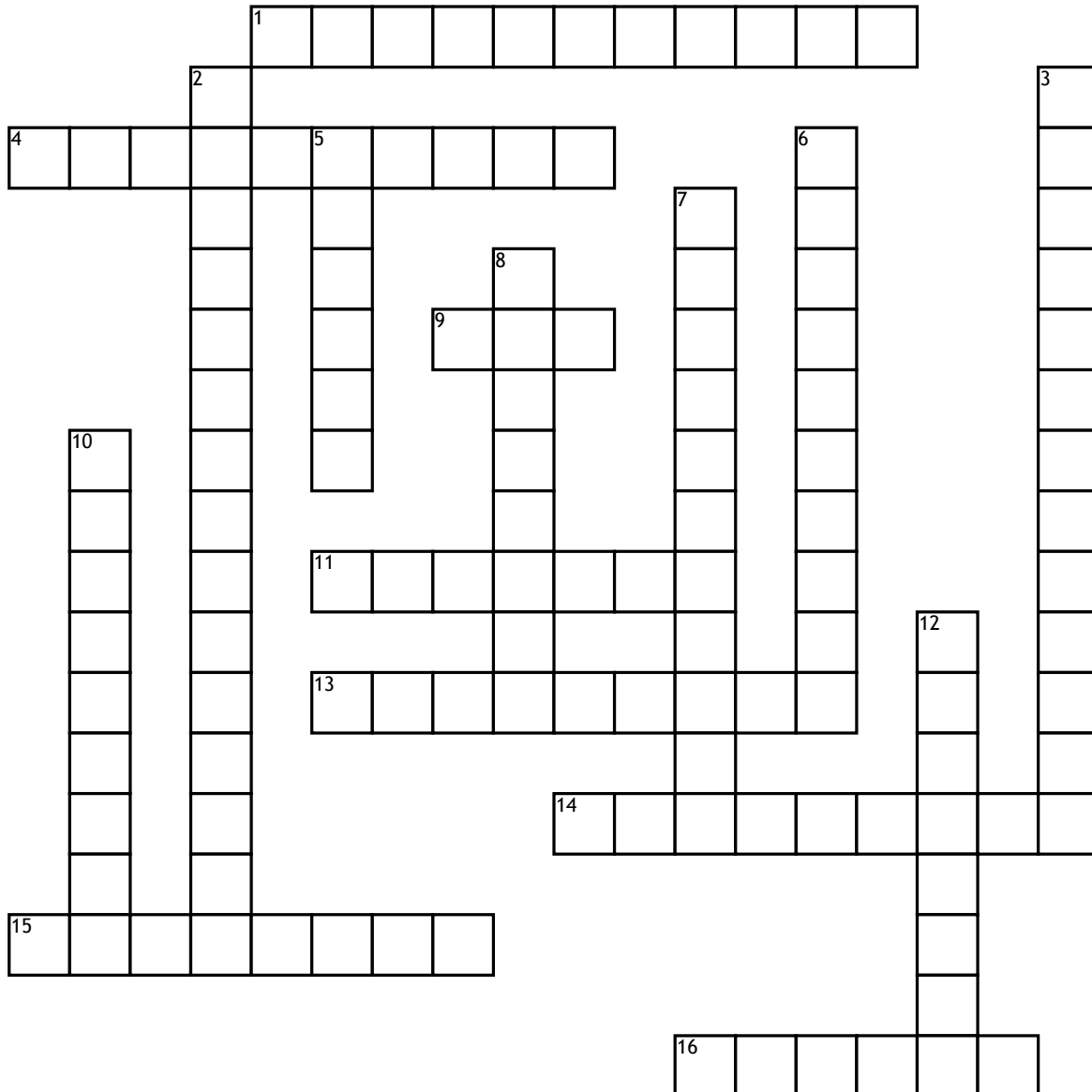

1. a topographic map with the contour lines representing depth below sea level, rather than height above
4. the height or depth of a feature relative to sea level
9. a flat representation of Earth at a reduced scale, showing only selected detail
11. the parallel of 0 degrees latitude
13. a line connecting two different locations
14. height above or below sea level

15. the average height of the ocean's surface or the midpoint between high and low tide and is the same all around Earth

16. the difference in elevation between the highest and lowest points in an area

2. difference in altitude represented by space between two contour lines on a map
3. the meridian passing through the Royal Observatory at Greenwich, England, east of central London, and from which longitude is measured

5. the difference in elevation between the highest and lowest points in an area

6. a way to represent the Earth's curved surface on flat paper

7. a line on map joining points of equal elevation

8. relationship between distance measured on a map and the actual distance on the Earth's surface

10. location described as an angle measured east and west from the prime meridian on Earth's surface

12. location described as an angle measured north and south of the equator
