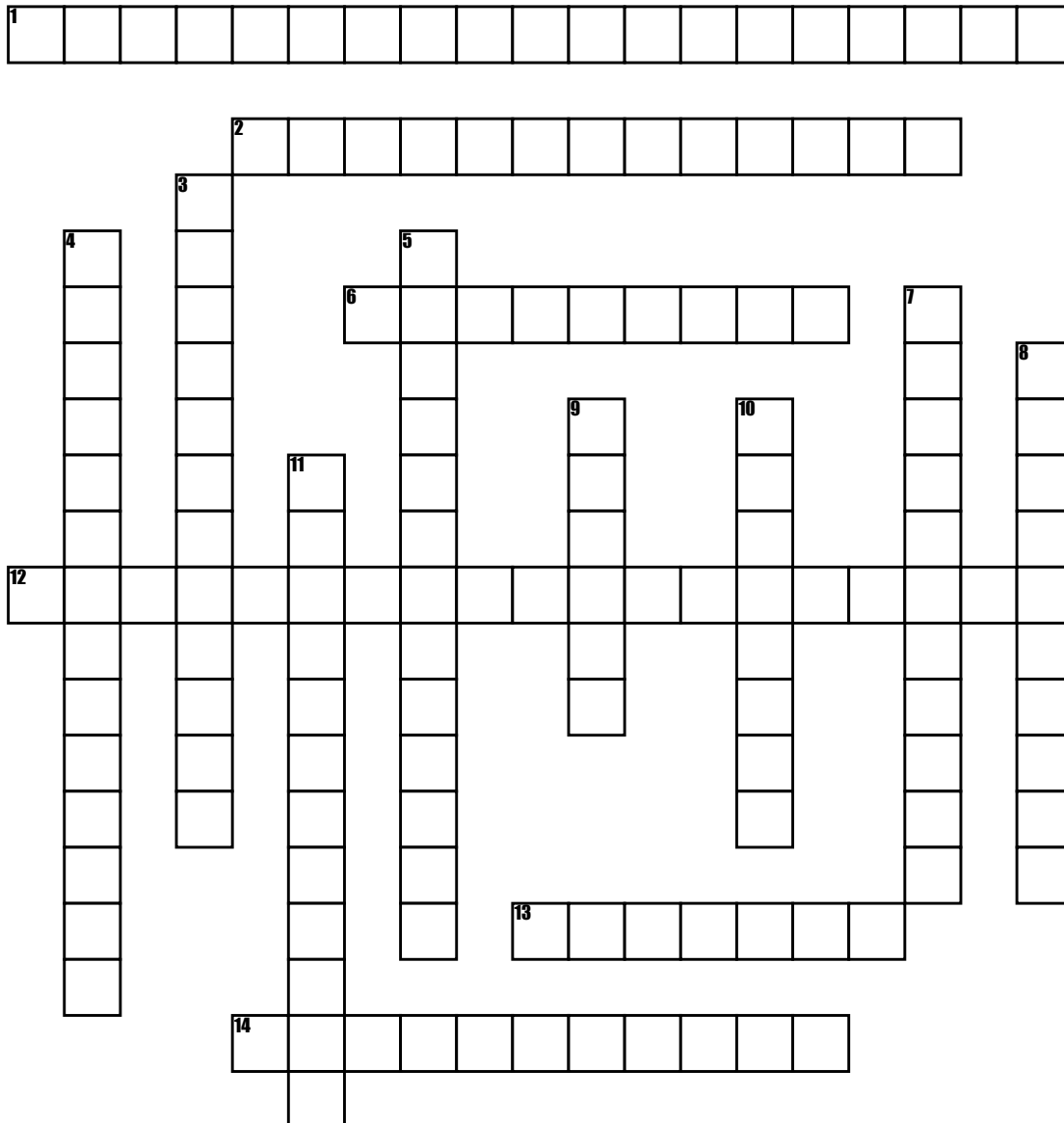


# Marriage Equality
