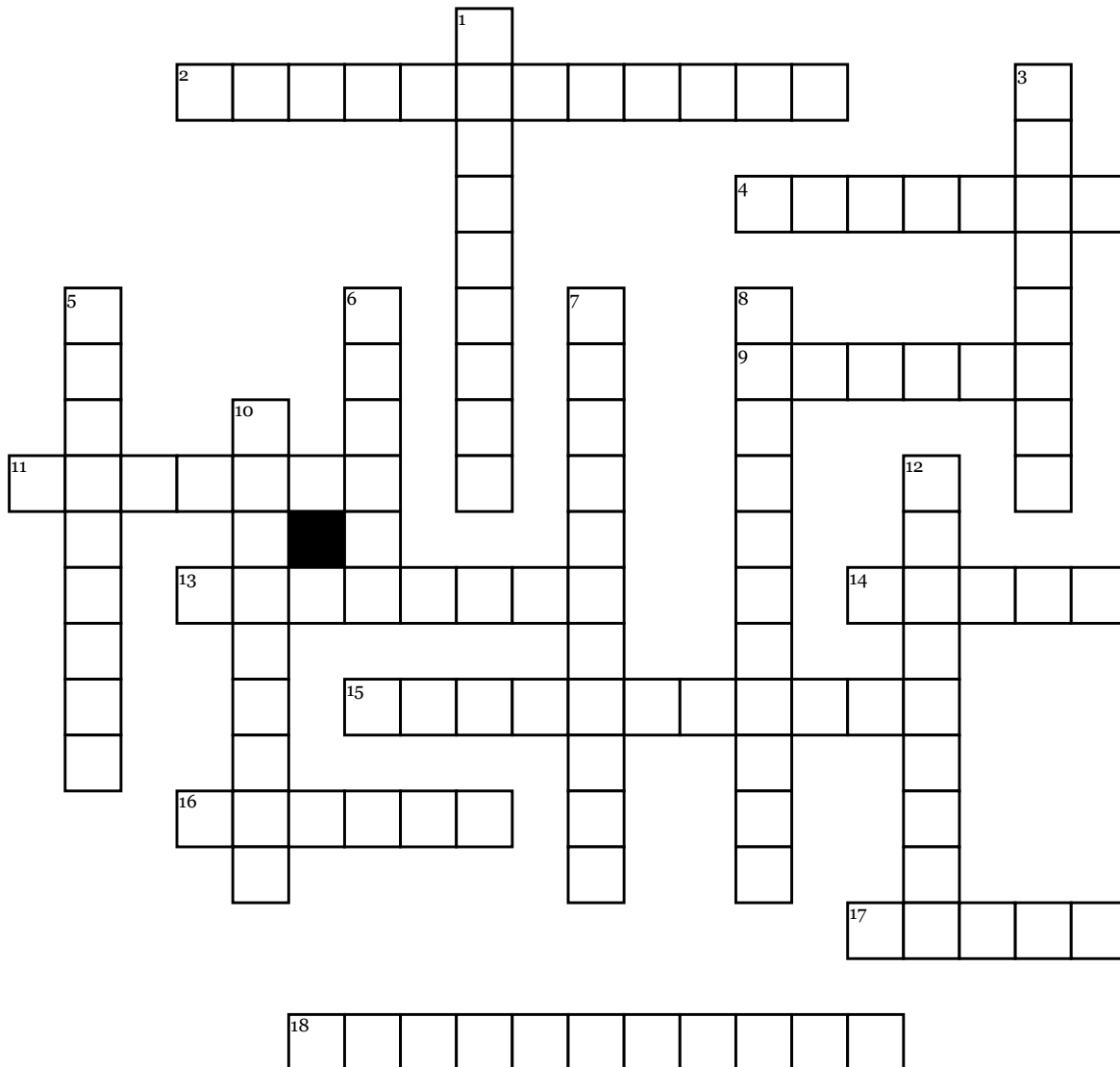


# Masque of The Red Death Crossword
