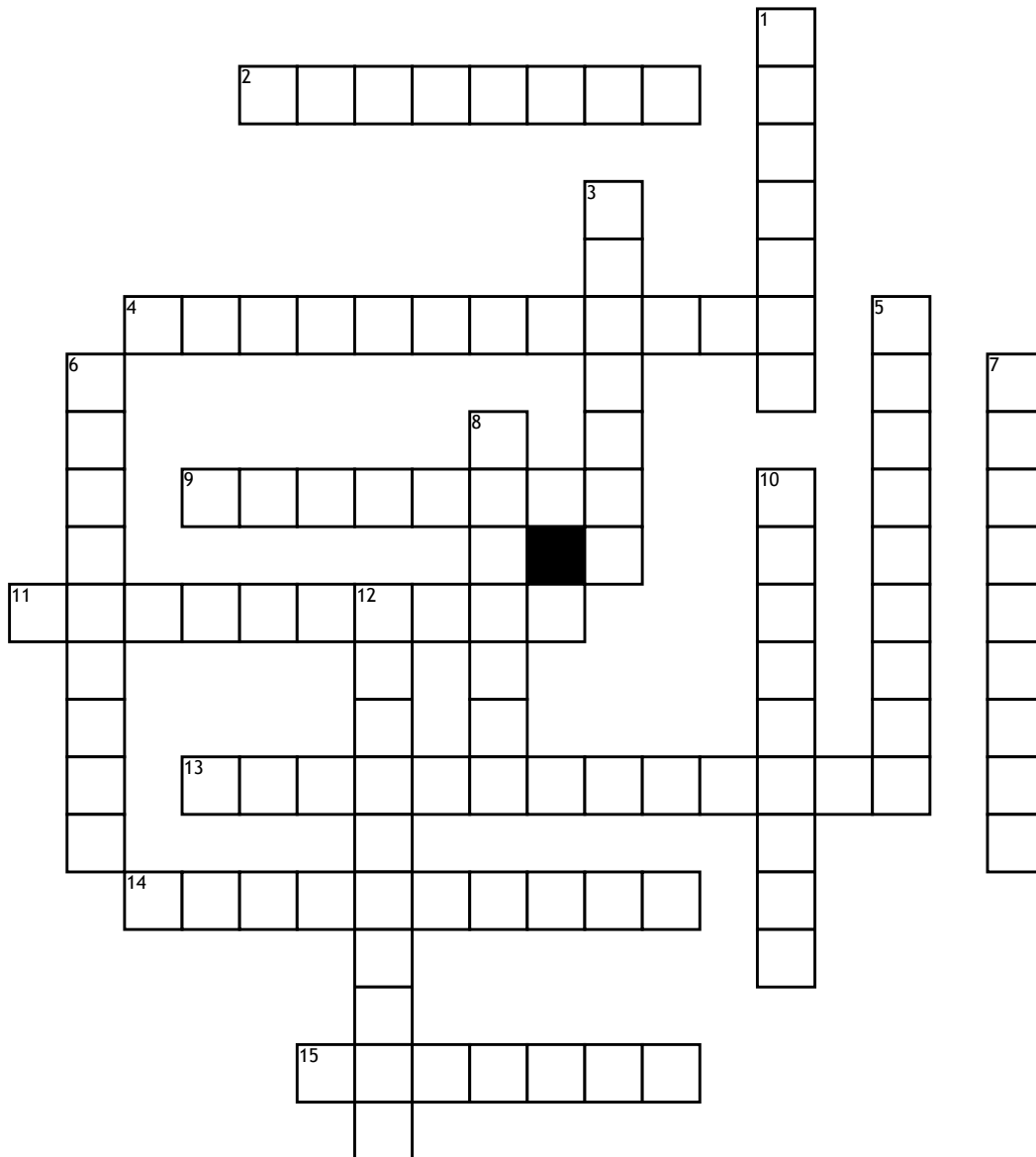


Matched Crossword
