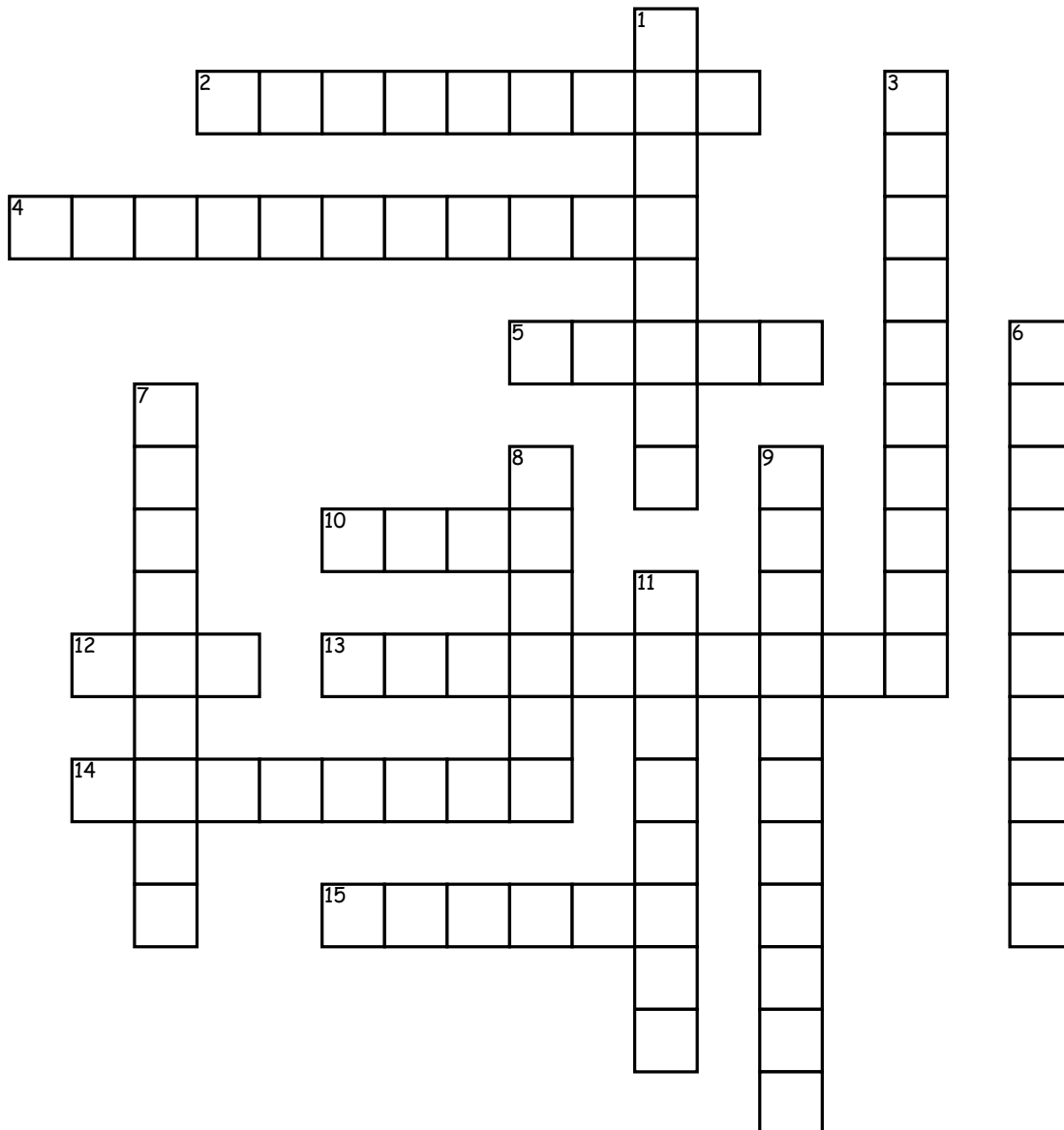


Math Crossword
