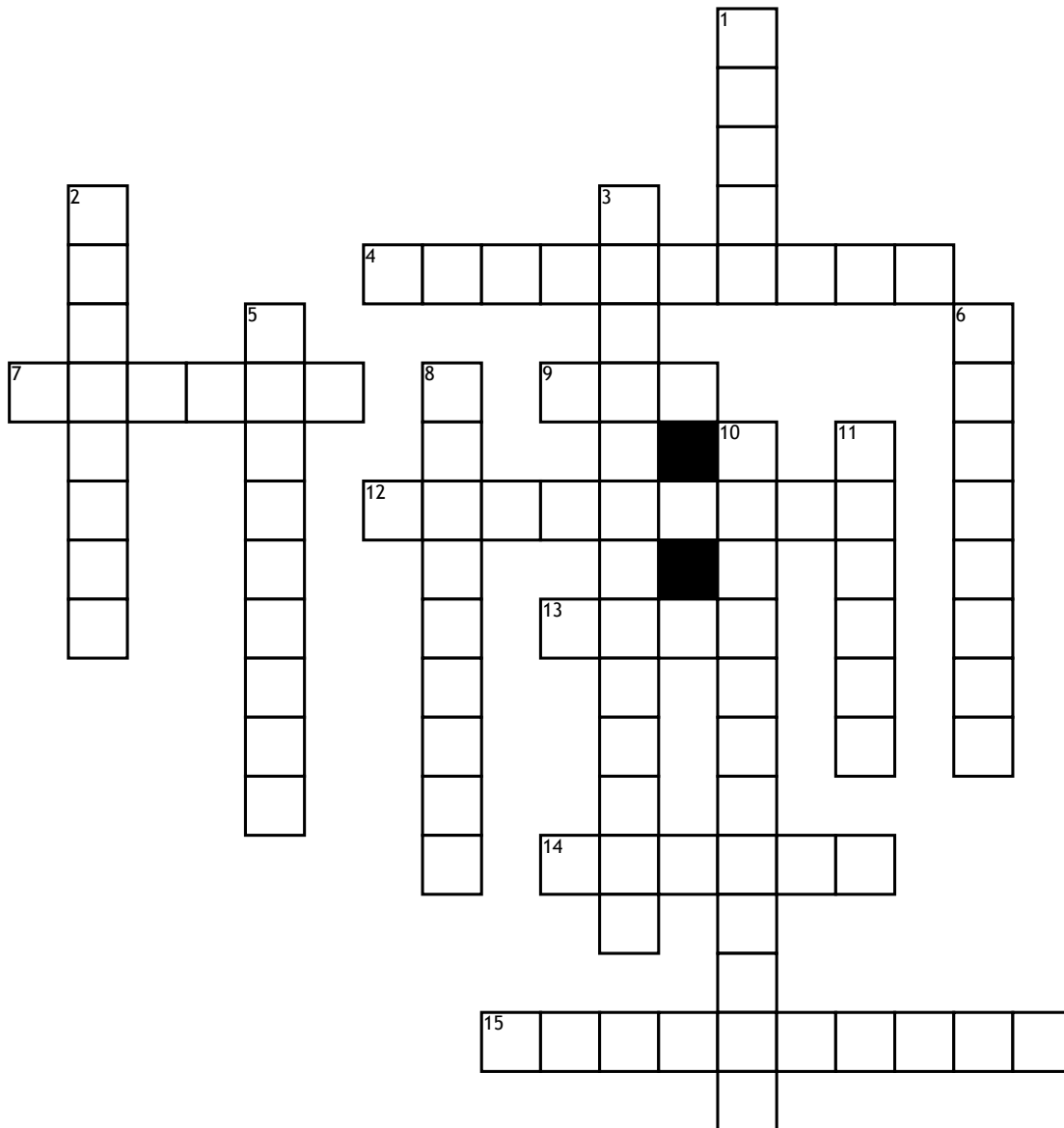


Maths Crossword
