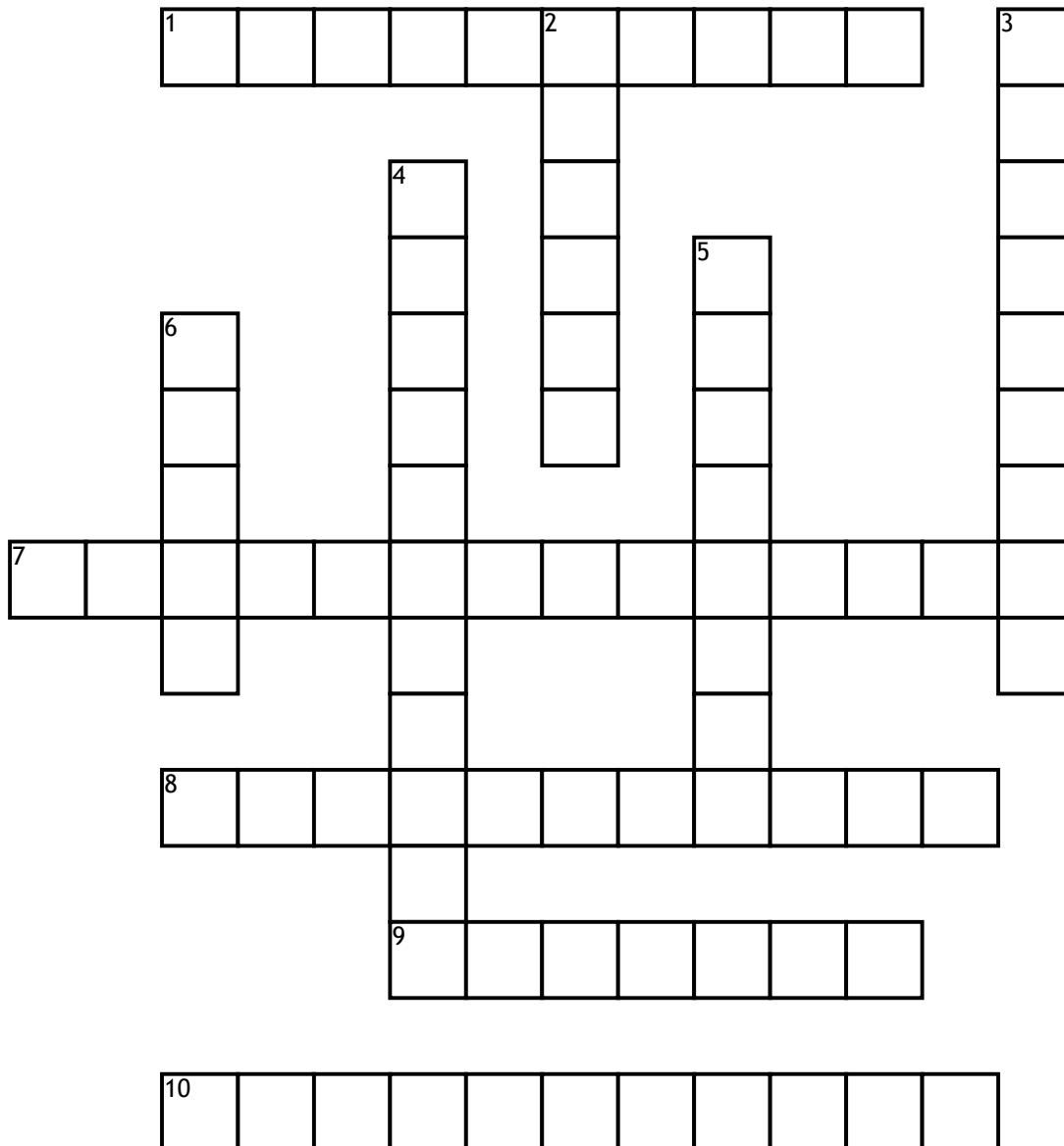


McCarthy Trials vs. Salem Trials
