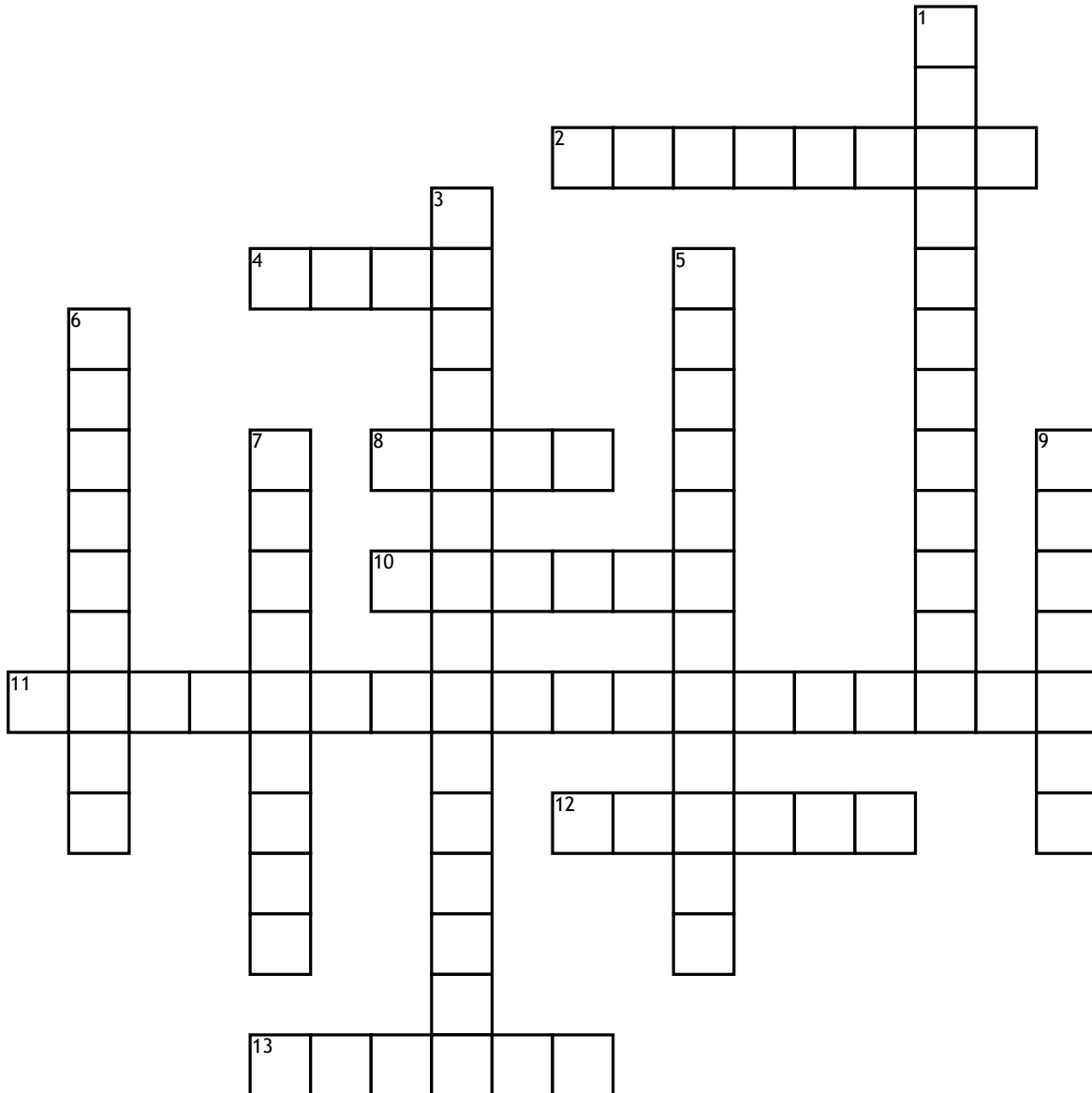


Mcas cross word puzzle
