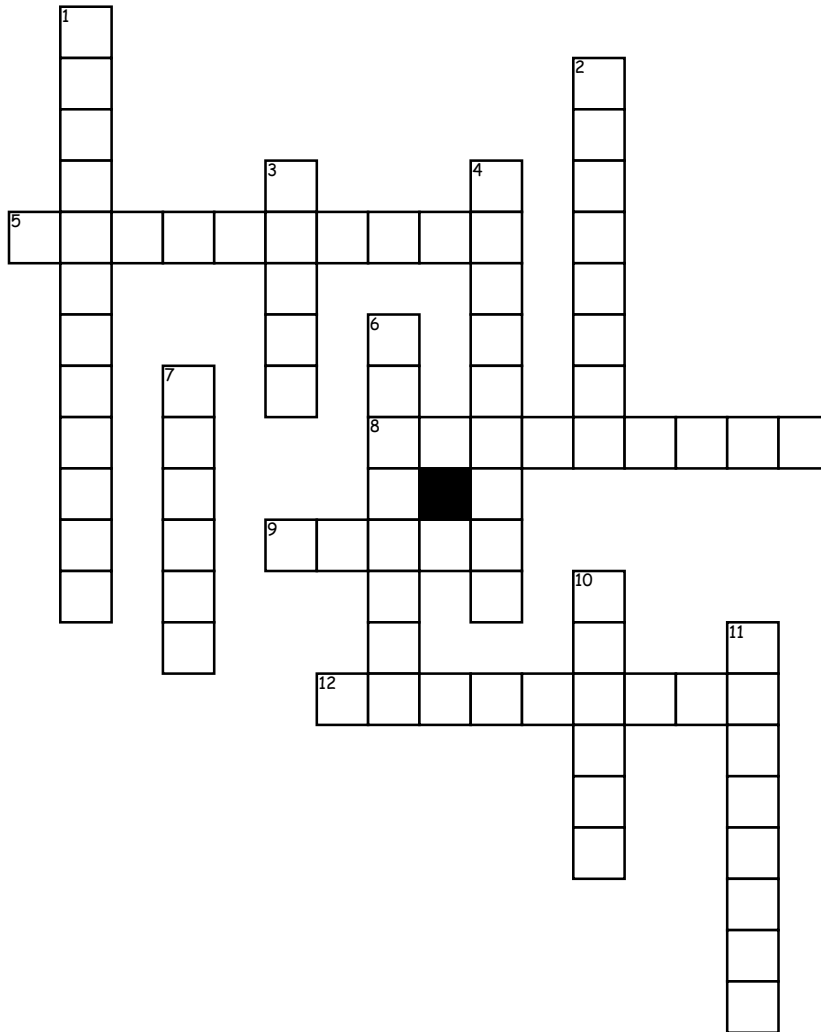


Medea Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
