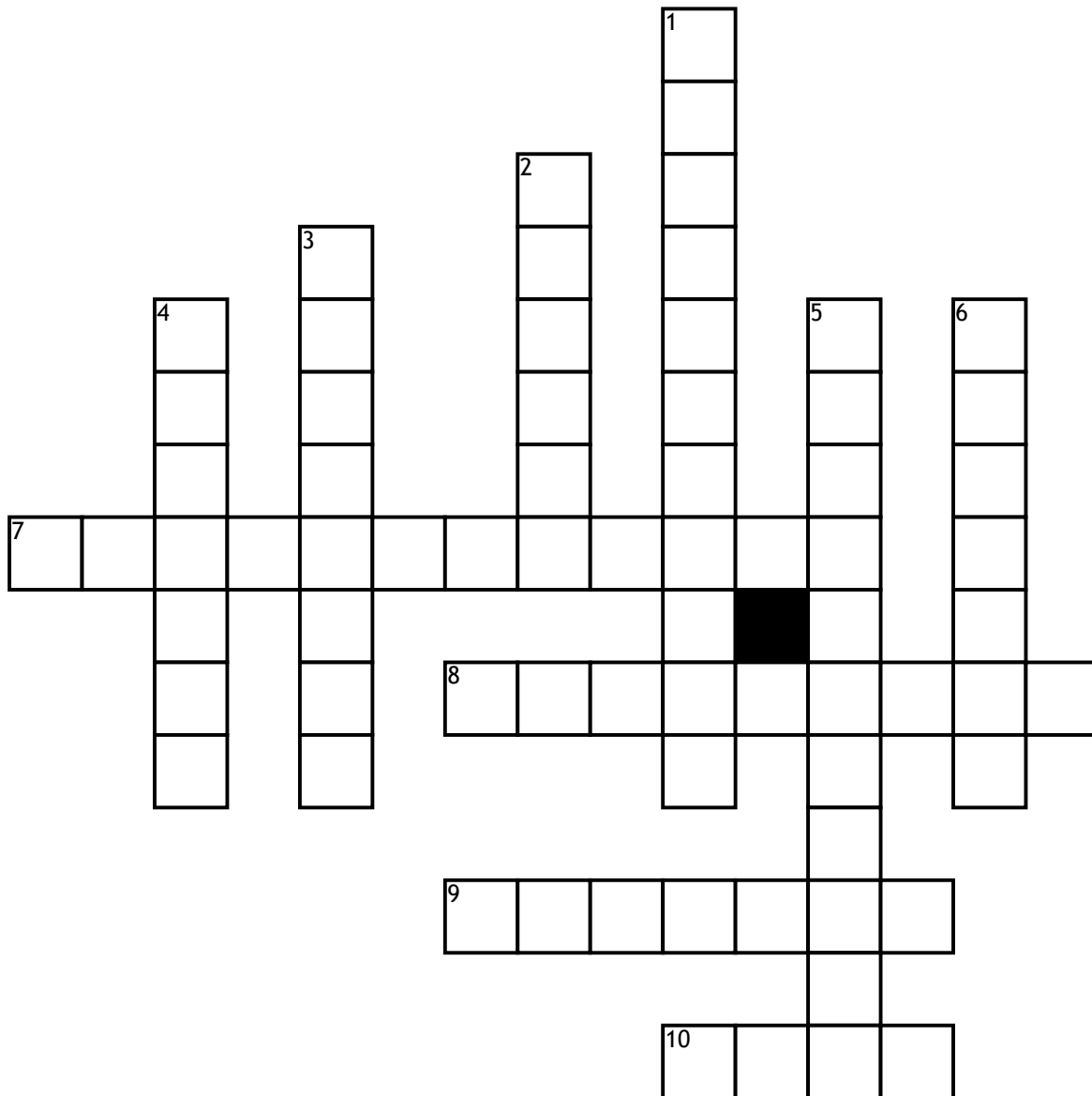


Medieval Europe crossword
