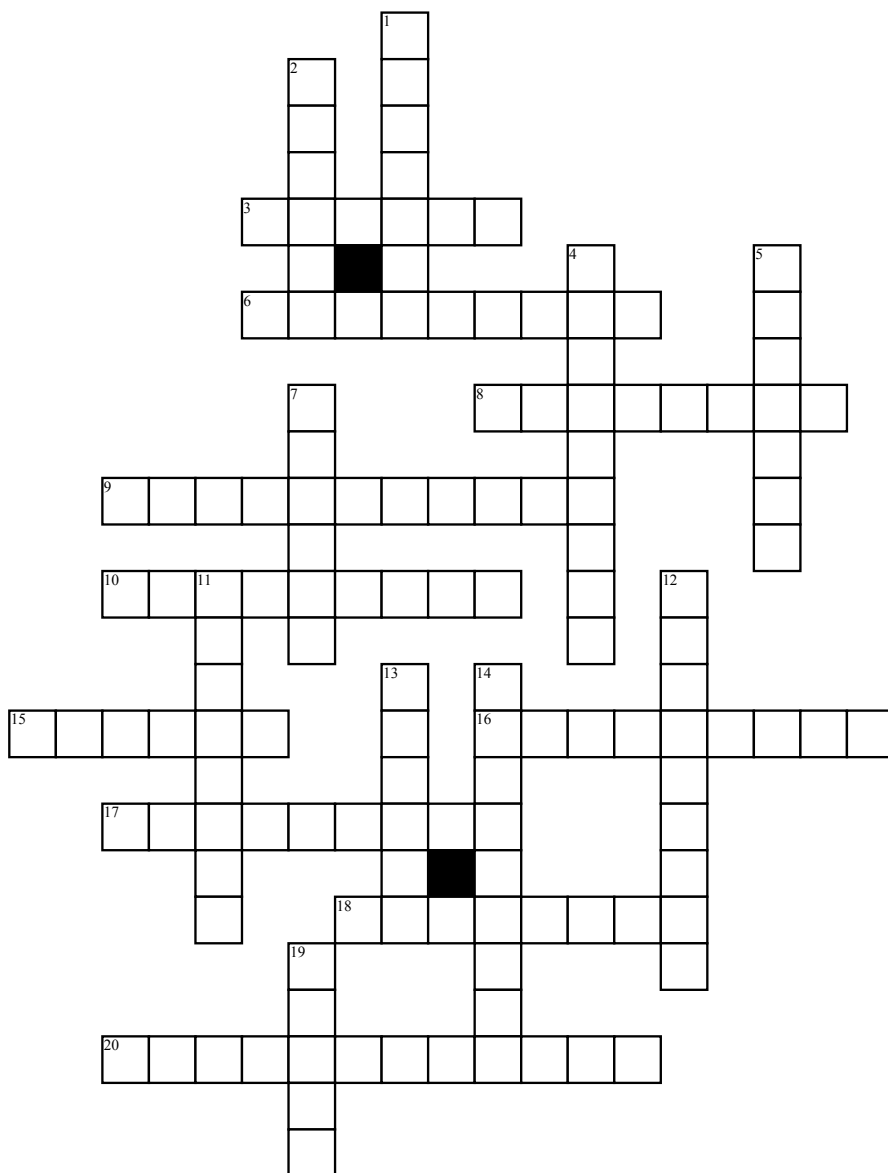


Michelle Mitchell The Hate U Give Crossword
