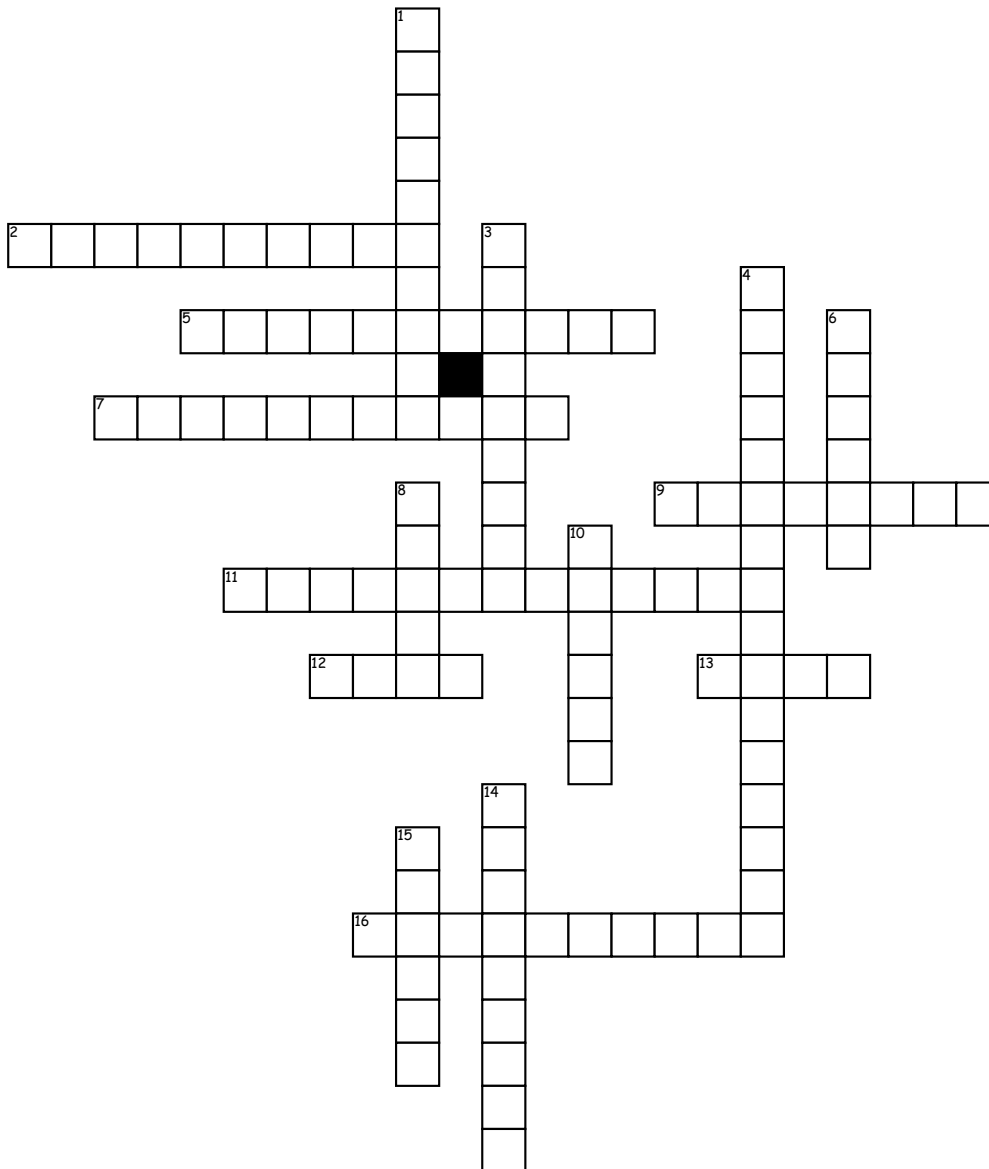


Middle Ages Crossword Puzzle
