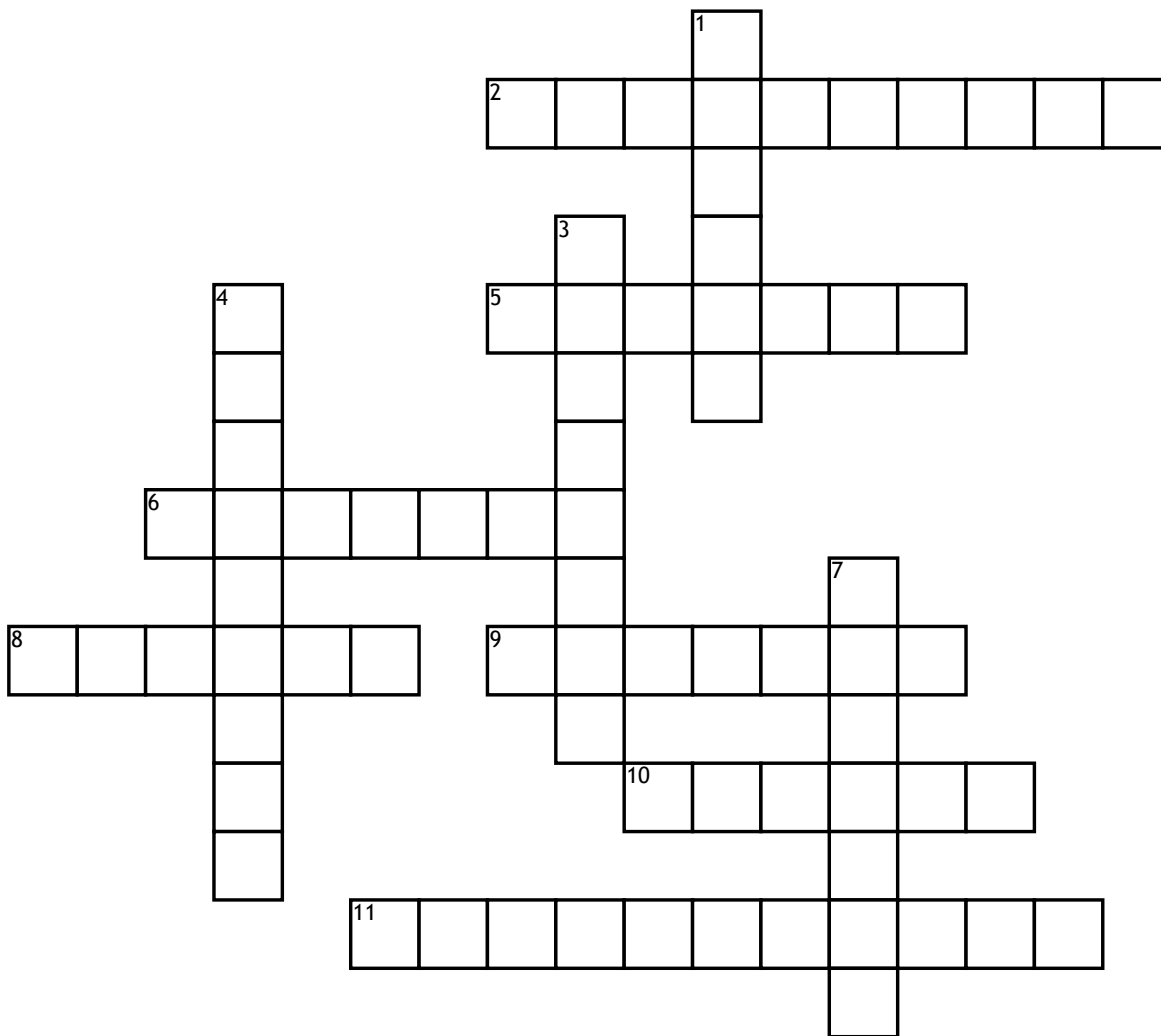


Mixtures and Solutions

- 2. A mixture of a solid and liquid, where the solid bits are heavy enough to settle out if the mixture is left to stand.
- 5. Describes a substance that can dissolve in a liquid.
- 6. The liquid in which a substance dissolves to make a solution.
- 8. The substance that has dissolved in a liquid to make a solution.
- 9. A mixture of a solid, liquid or gas in a solid, liquid or gas, where the substances do not settle out if left to stand.

10. To separate solid substances that have not dissolved from a mixture containing solids and liquid. The liquid is passed through a filter (such as filter paper) to do this.

11. Clear, can be seen through - substances may be coloured or colourless.
