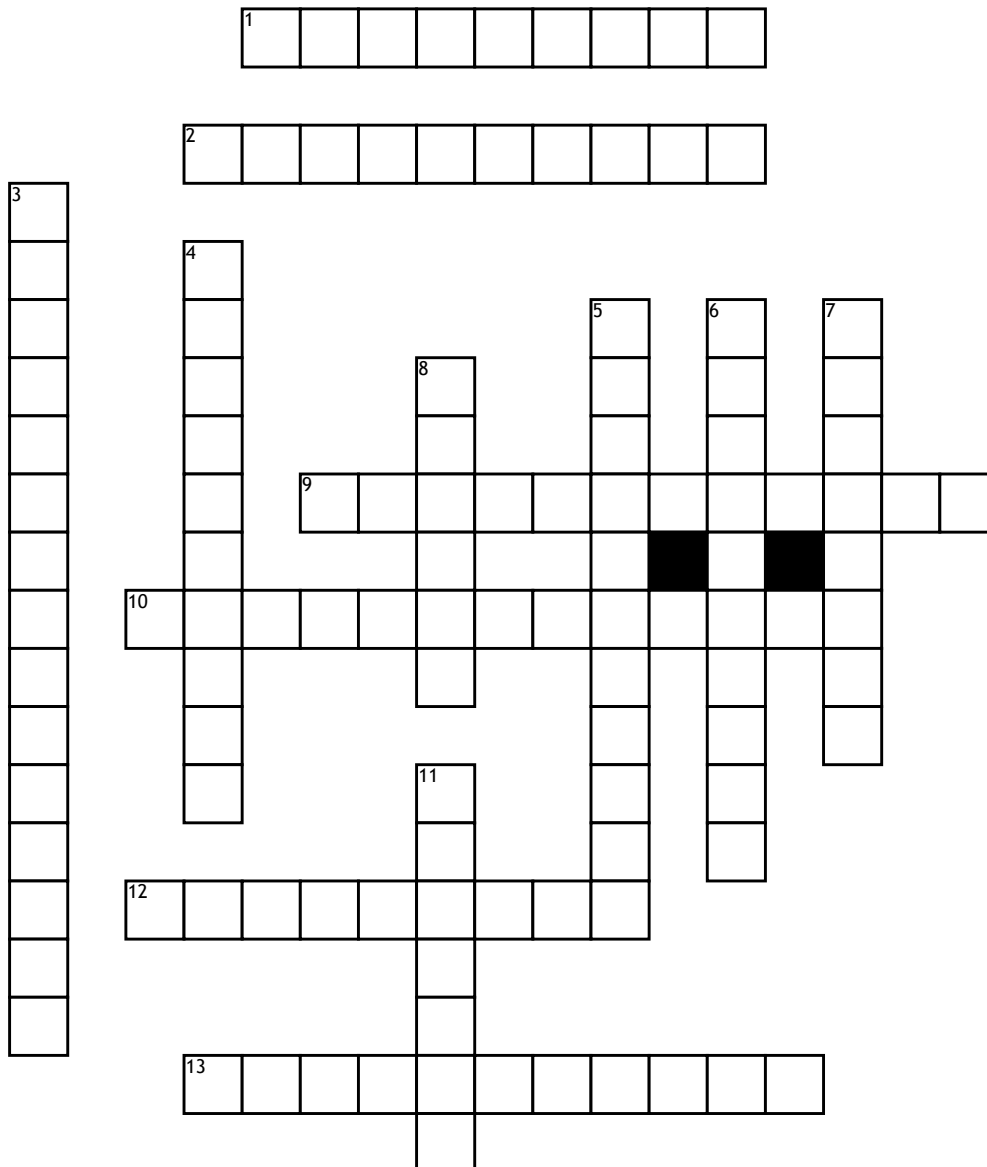

1. The damage that can be done to eyes after exposure to ultraviolet light from arc welding
2. The joining of metal parts by fusion
9. Wood or metal braces placed diagonally from the bottom of one rail to the top of another rail to add support to a structure
10. A work area large enough for a person to work in but with limited means of entry and exit
12. Capable of easily igniting and rapidly burning

13. An unintentional electrically conducting connection between an ungrounded conductor and the earth

3. A person who is capable of identifying existing and predictable hazards in the surroundings and who has authorization to take prompt corrective measures to eliminate them
4. The temperature at which fuel gives off enough gases (vapors) to burn

5. Capable of easily igniting and rapidly burning
6. Any man-made cut cavity trench or depression in an earth surface formed by removing earth
7. An unplanned event that results in personal injury or property damage
8. The conducting connection between electrical equipment or an electrical circuit and the earth
11. A process of using heat in excess of 800 degrees to melt a filler metal that is drawing into a connection
