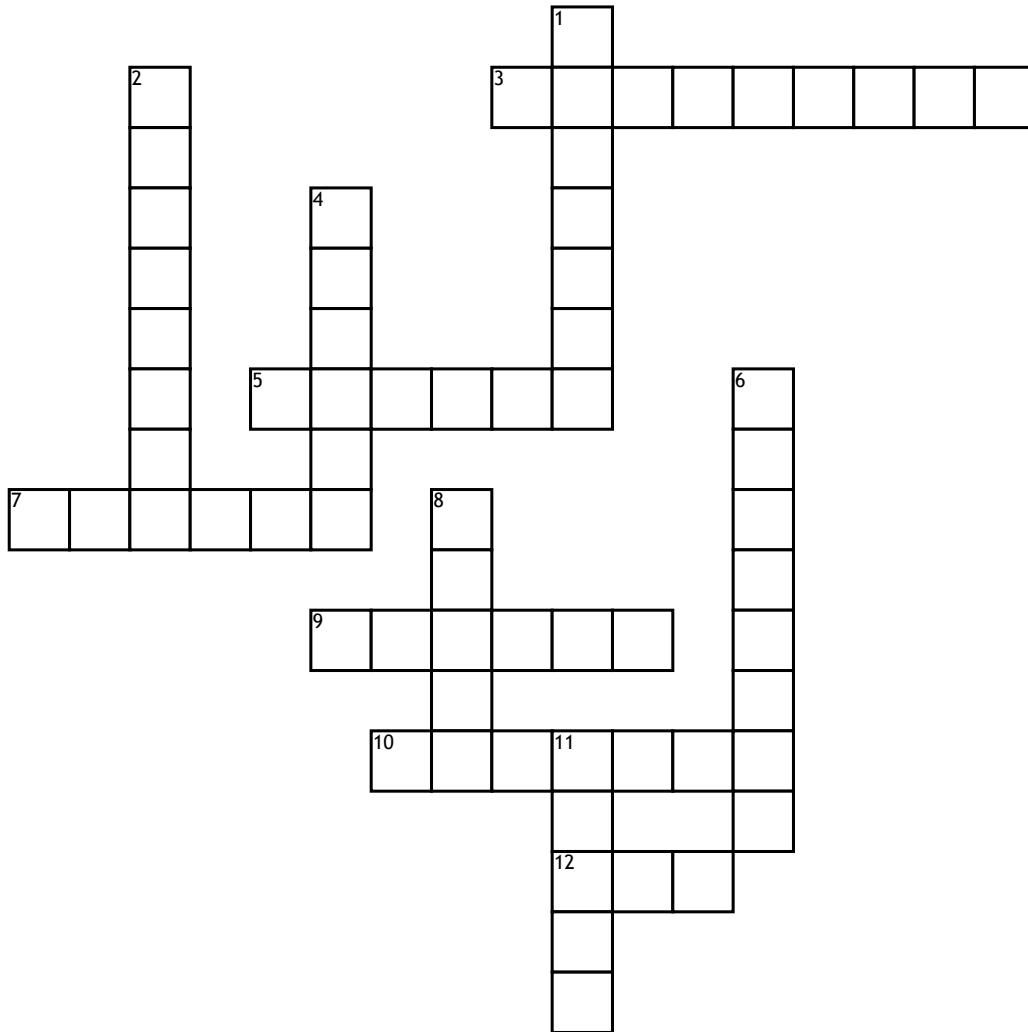

- 10. Phase of the moon when none of the visible part of the moon is illuminated by the sun.
- 12. White lines that extend in all directions from some craters.

- 1. The shape of the moon when the illuminated part is less than a circle but more than a quarter.
- 2. The phase of the moon when the entire moon is illuminated by the sun.

- 4. When a moon phase is increasing or getting larger.
- 6. Phase of the moon showing an arc-shaped section of the moon that is illuminated by the sun.
- 8. Appearance presented by the moon.
- 11. Large dark-grey or black areas of the moon that are fairly smooth.
