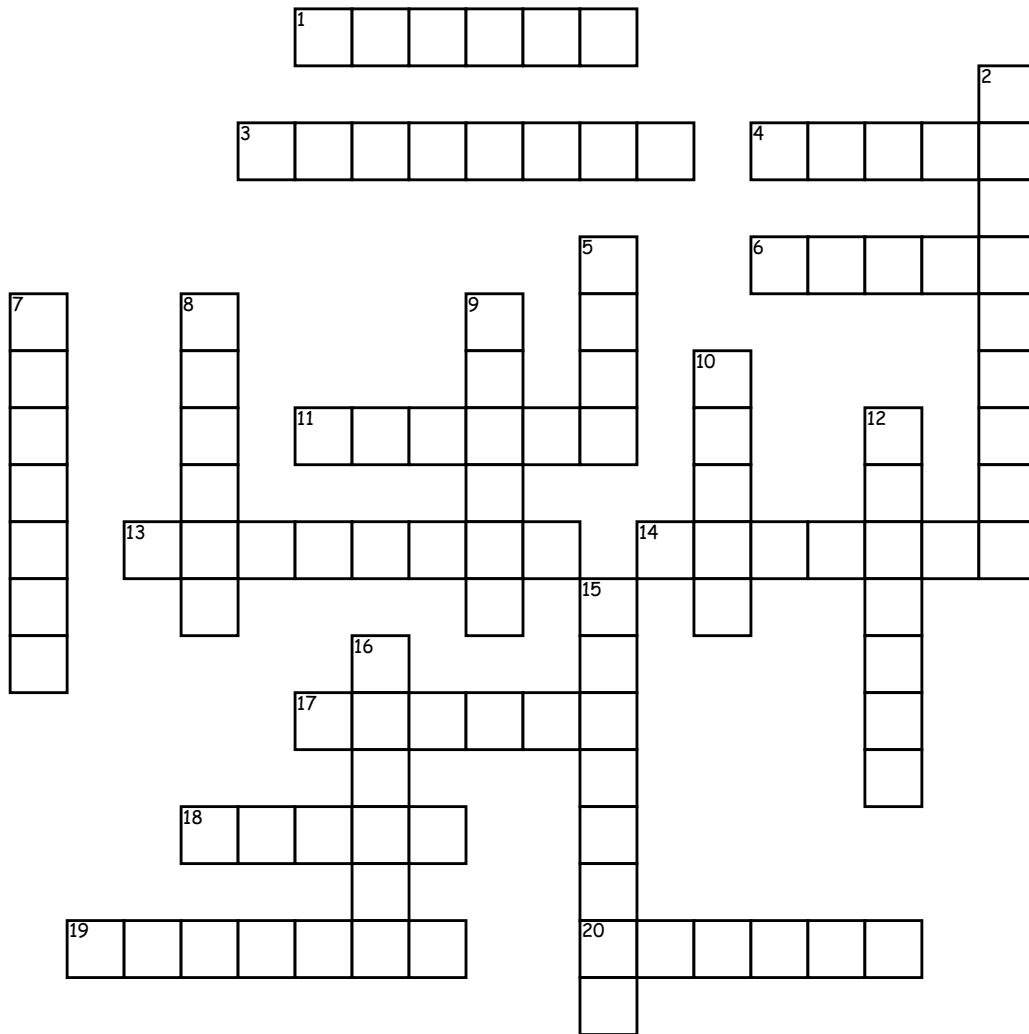


Moons of other planets

1. is the largest natural satellite of the planet Neptune
 3. is the second-largest moon of Jupiter, after *Ganymede*.
 4. is the largest moon of Saturn.
 6. is a moon of Saturn.
 11. is the smallest of the four *Galilean* moons orbiting Jupiter
 13. is a moon of Saturn
 14. is the third-largest natural satellite of Saturn

17. is the largest of the five known natural satellites of the dwarf planet Pluto.
 18. is the fourth-largest of the 27 known moons of Uranus
 19. is a moon of Uranus discovered on October 24, 1851
 20. is the smaller and outer of the two natural satellites of the planet Mars

2. is the sixth-largest moon of Saturn. It is about 500 kilometers in diameter
 5. is the second-largest moon of Saturn

7. is the smallest and innermost of Uranus's five round satellites
 8. is a mid-sized moon of Saturn about 1,060 km across
 9. is the innermost and larger of the two natural satellites of Mars
 10. is a moon of Saturn which was discovered in 1789 by William Herschel.
 12. is the largest of the moons of Uranus
 15. is the largest and most massive moon of Jupiter and in the Solar System.
 16. is an irregular satellite of Saturn
