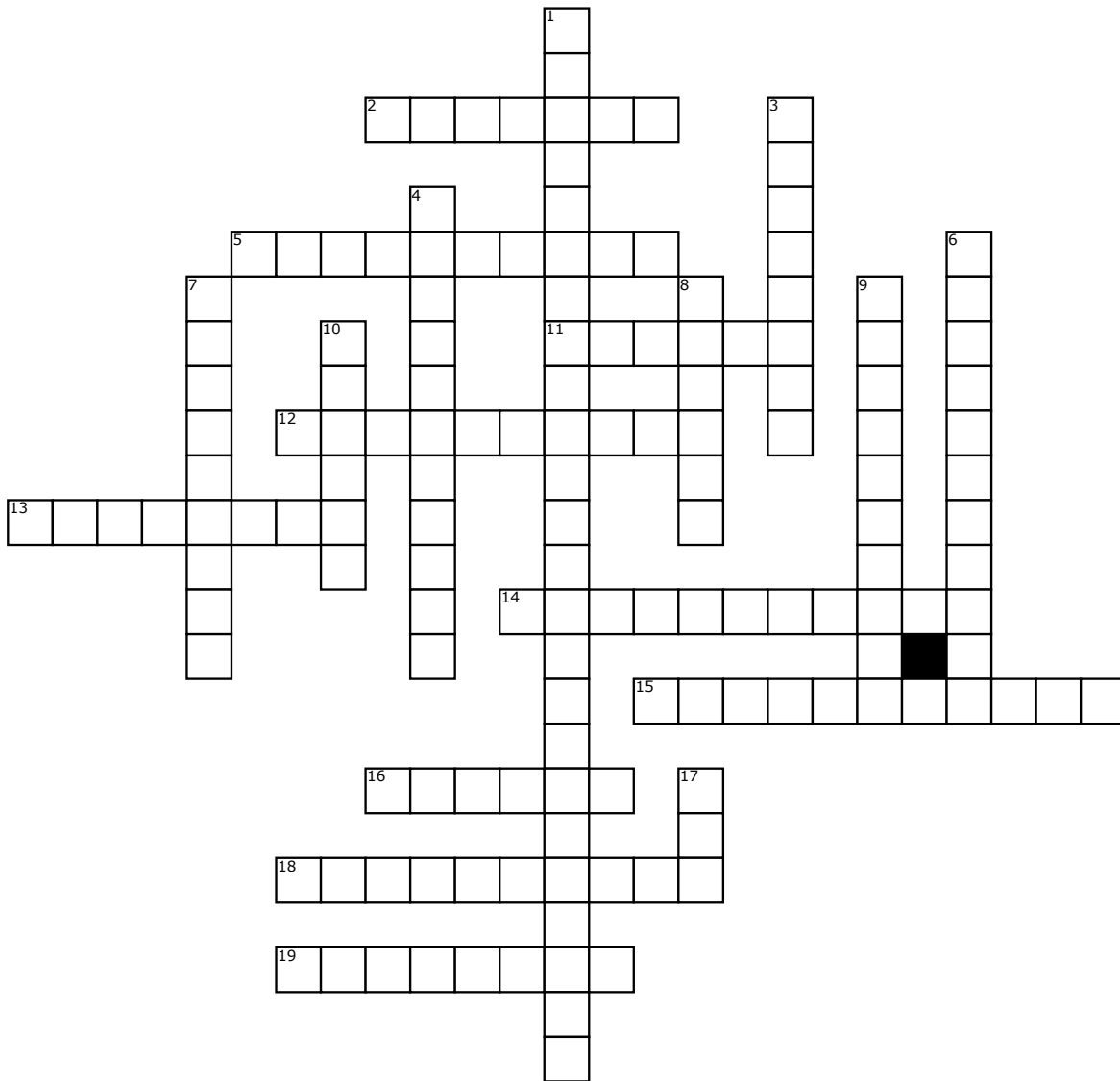


Morphology and Syntax Crossword Puzzle
