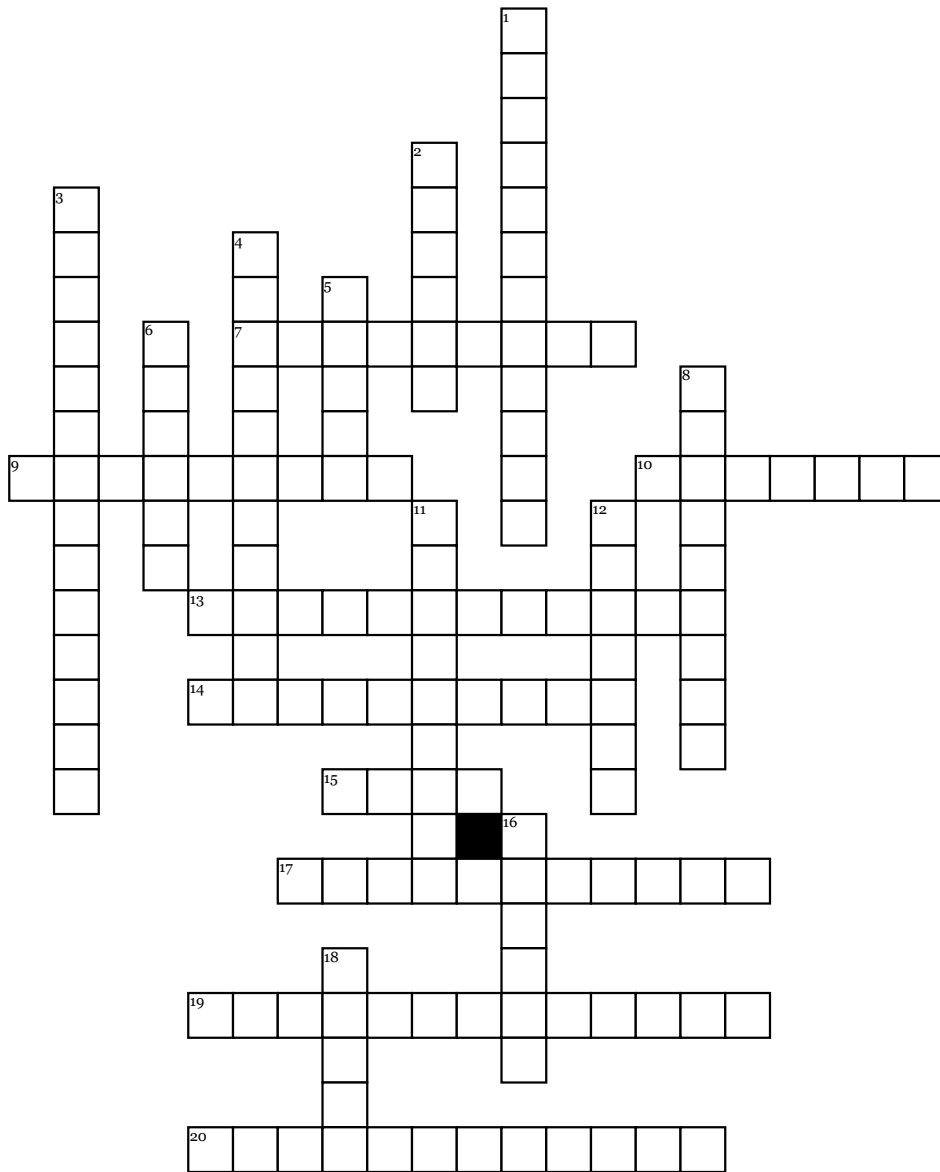


# Mountains

**10.** Mountain with a vent for lava or gases which can erupt  
**13.** third highest mountain in the world, and lies partly in Nepal and partly in Sikkim, India  
**14.** potentially active stratovolcano in the Cascade Range.

**4.** this mountain contains three volcanic cones, Kibo, Mawenzi, and Shira  
**5.** the \_\_\_\_\_ plate moved rapidly northwards towards Euro Asia plate to form Mount Everest  
**6.** highest mountain peak in North America
