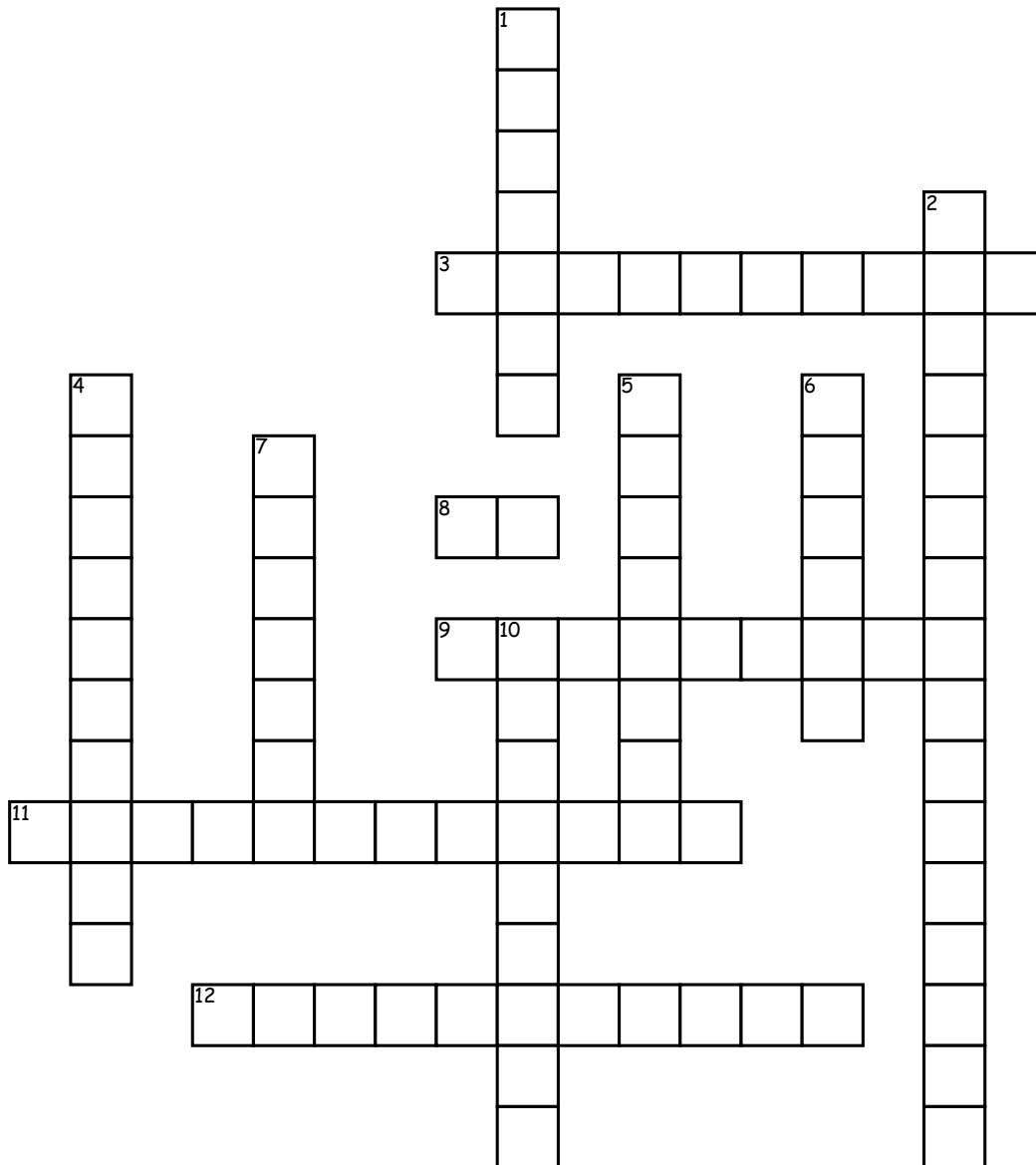


# Mountains, Origins, and their Locations

3. This is the highest mountain in Grand Teton National Park, in Northwest Wyoming.

8. This is the second highest mountain in the world, after Mount Everest.

9. This is a mountain in the Himalaya range of eastern Nepal. The main peak is 6,812 metres.

11. is the highest summit in the contiguous United States and the Sierra Nevada, with an elevation of 14,505 feet.

12. This has three volcanic cones, "Kibo", "Mawenzi", and "Shira", is a dormant volcano in Tanzania. It is the highest mountain in Africa.

**Down**

1. This is a mountain in Patagonia, on the border between Argentina and Chile.

2. This is the highest mountain in New Zealand. Its height since 2014 is listed as 3,724 metres, down from 3,764 m before December 1991, due to a rockslide and subsequent erosion.

4. This is a mountain of the Alps, in between Switzerland and Italy.

5. This is a granite dome at the eastern end of Yosemite Valley in California.

6. This is the highest mountain peak in North America.

7. This is the highest mountain in the world.

10. This is the highest mountain in the Alps and the highest in Europe west of Russia's Caucasus peaks.
