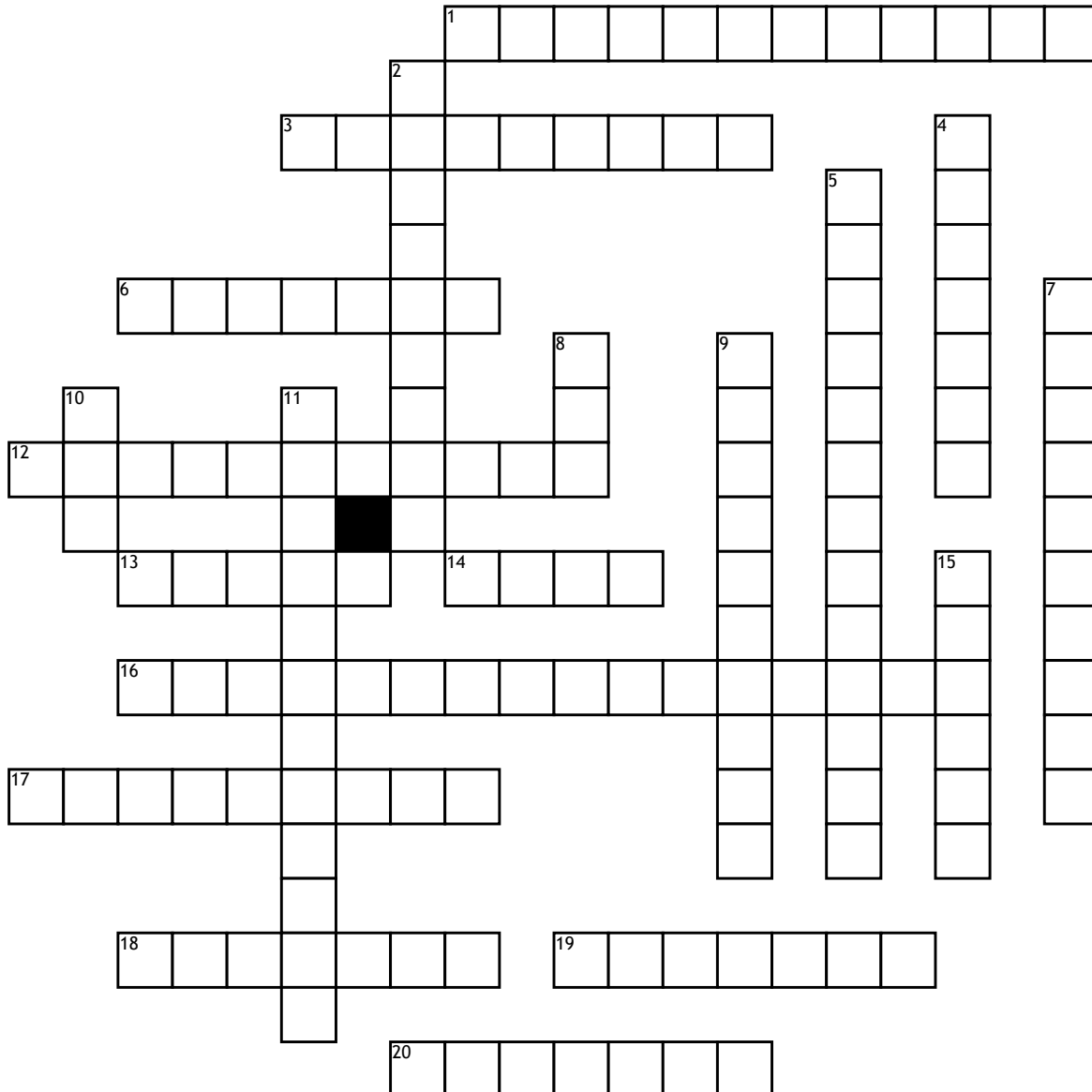


Multiple Sclerosis
