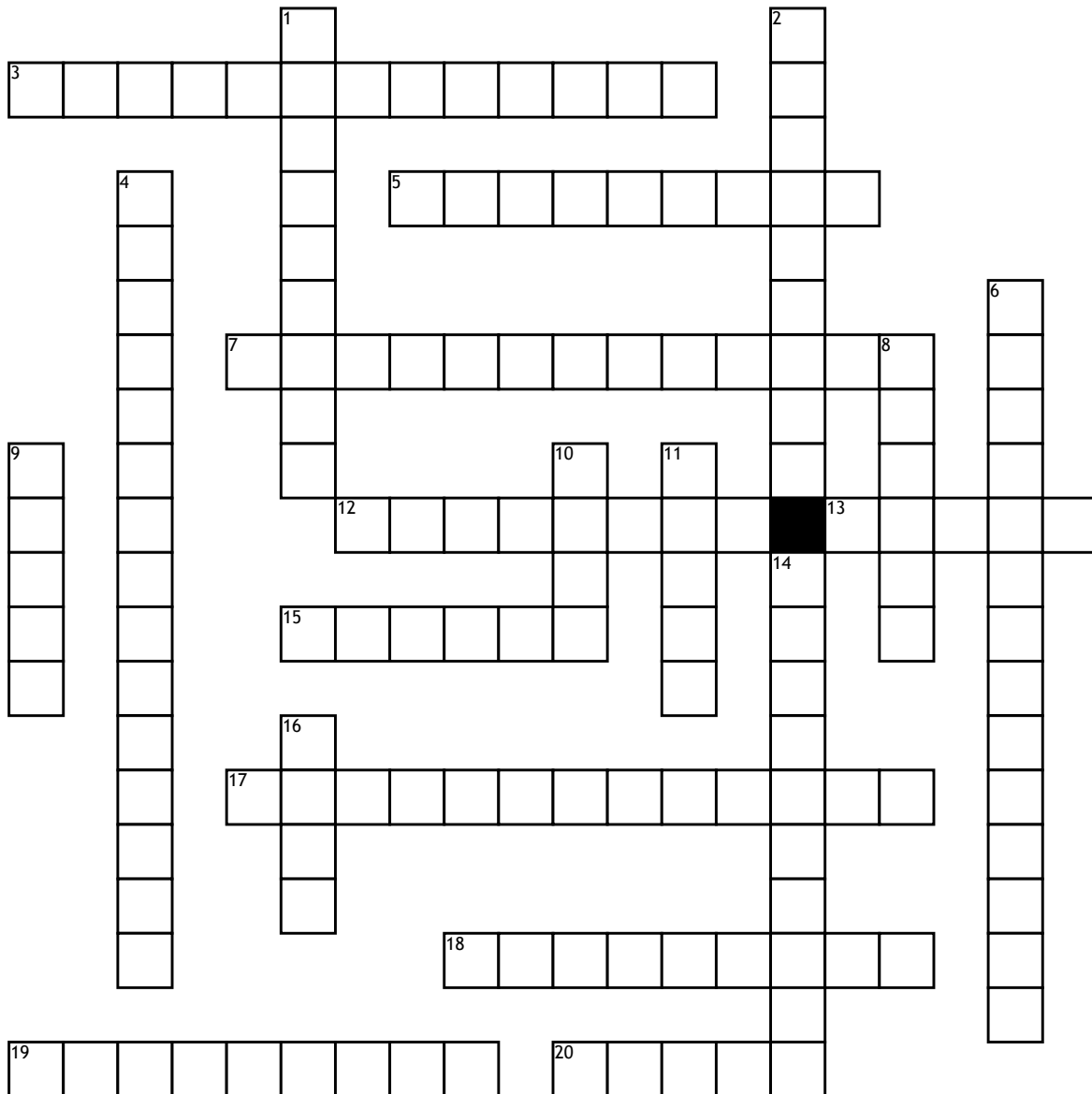


Muscles of the Lower Limb
