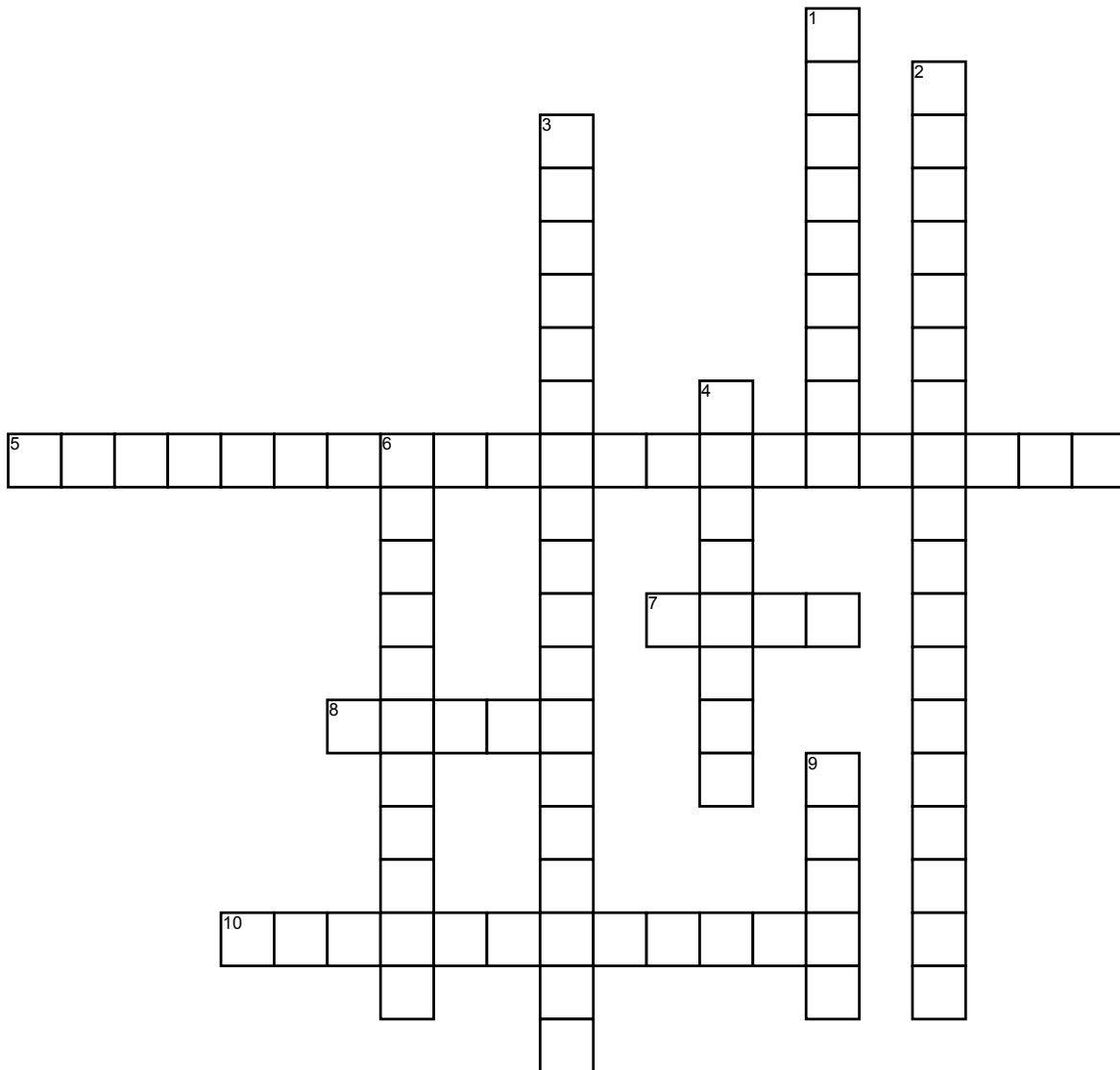

Musculoskeletal System



Across

- 5. Provides the frame work for the body and allows the body to move
- 7. Flat bones which have a protective role
- 8. The head forms a ball and socket joint with the hip, being held in place by a ligament within the socket and by strong surrounding ligaments
- 10. Enclosing the joint in a strong sleeve like cover

Down

- 1. Hard dense bones that provide strength, structure and mobility
- 2. Allows movement in all directions
- 3. Lines the articulating surface of each of the two bones, forming smooth surface within the joint
- 4. The largest, strongest and lowest bone in the human race
- 6. Allows for wide range of motion between two articulating bones that are saddle shaped
- 9. Hard rigid structures that are made up of living cells surrounded by minerals that have been deposited by the living cell
