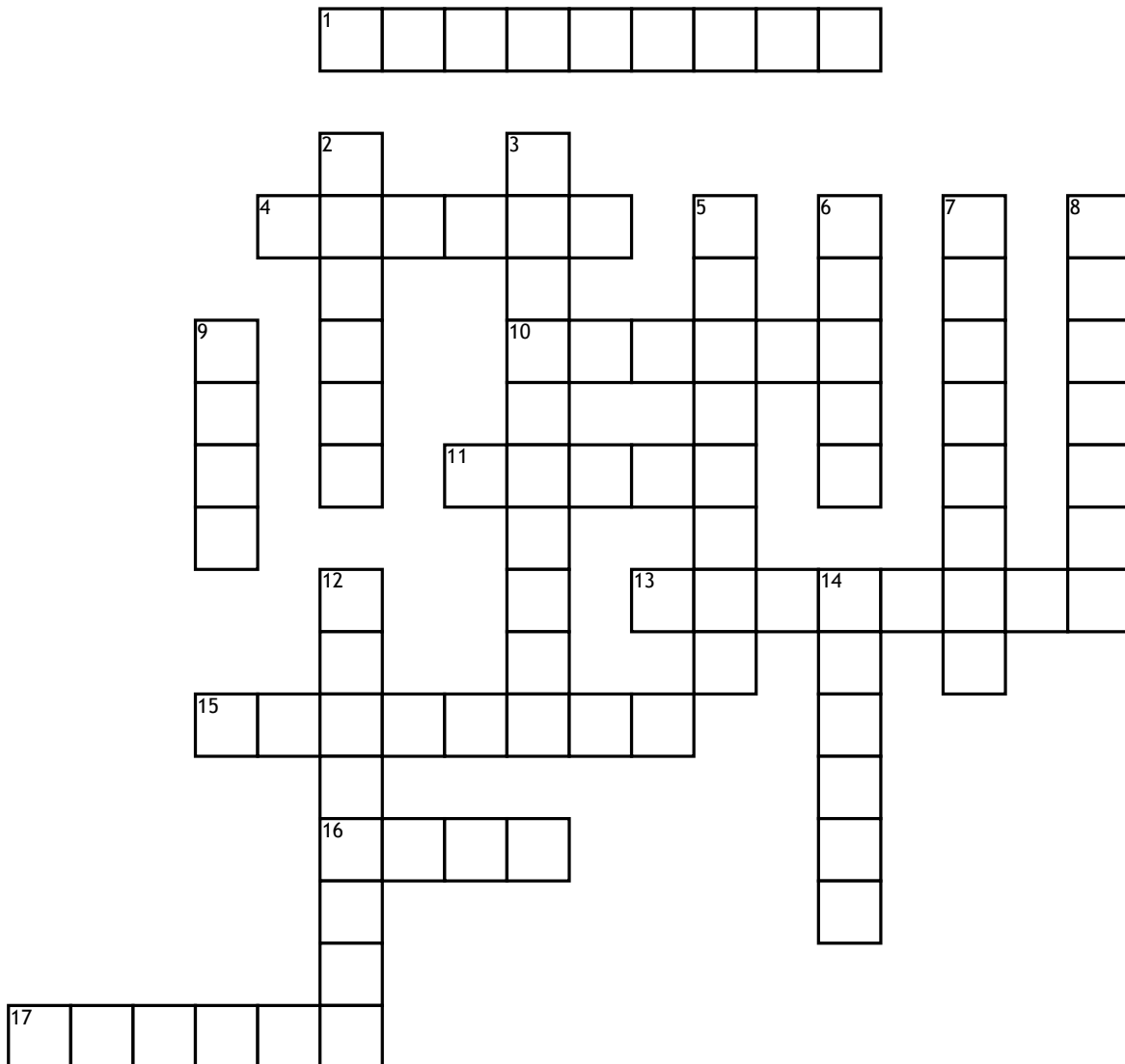


Music 8 - Semester 1 Terms



Across

- 1. Little by little
- 4. Means "in a similar way" - play the notes the the way previous ones were notated.
- 10. Emphasis put on a specific note, or on a group of notes.
- 11. Means you do not play. Indicates the instrument is silent during that time.
- 13. Go back to the sign and play till the fine.

- 15. Short, detached
- 16. Means "finish"
- 17. Like a musical sentence.

Down

- 2. Means "separate" - used to tell musicians that one player should play the top note and another should play the bottom note.
- 3. Play in the style of a march.
- 5. Play in a majestic style.
- 6. Means "All together"

- 7. A broken chord - also the part we play at the end of each scale (the 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 8th note of the scale).
- 8. A way to end a musical phrase. Typically played by two chords; five to one
- 9. Means "tail"
- 12. Go back to the beginning and play till the fine.
- 14. Play in a smooth, flowing manner with no breaks between notes.
