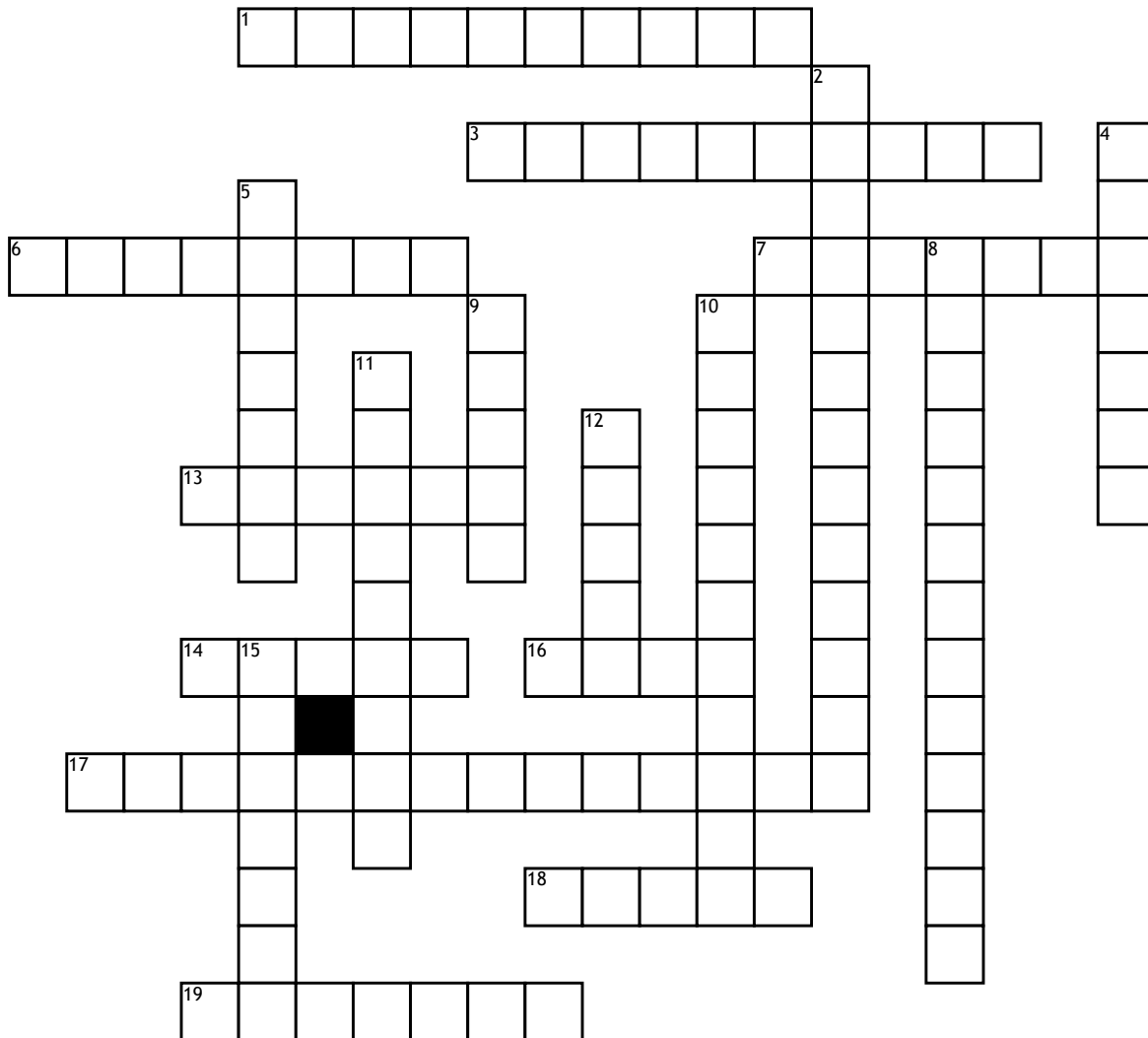

19. This means to hold a note or rest for as long as the director shows.
