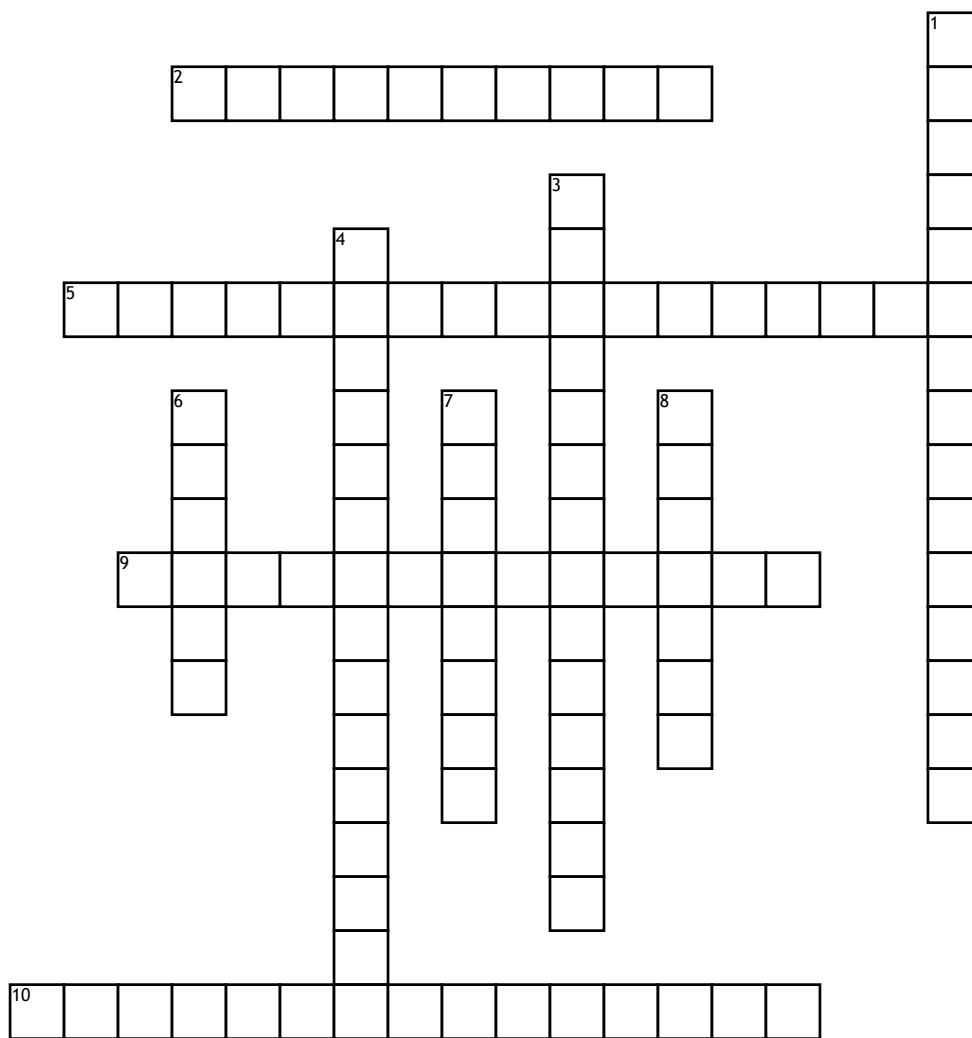


# Music Vocab

- 3. handing something down by listening
- 4. a musical scale with five notes per octave
- 6. a rope-tuned skin-covered goblet drum played with bare hands
- 7. a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm.
