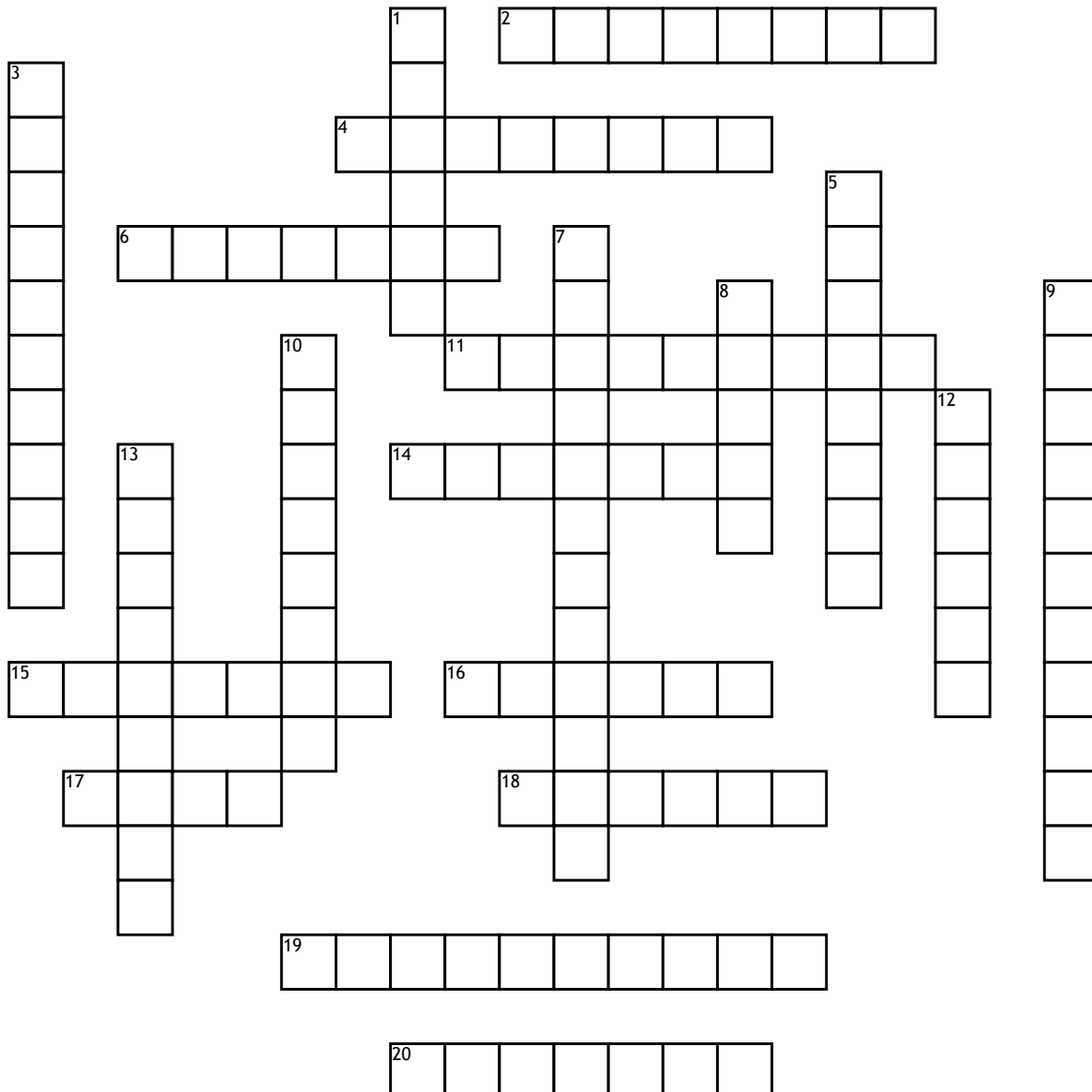


My Brother Sam is Dead Crossword
