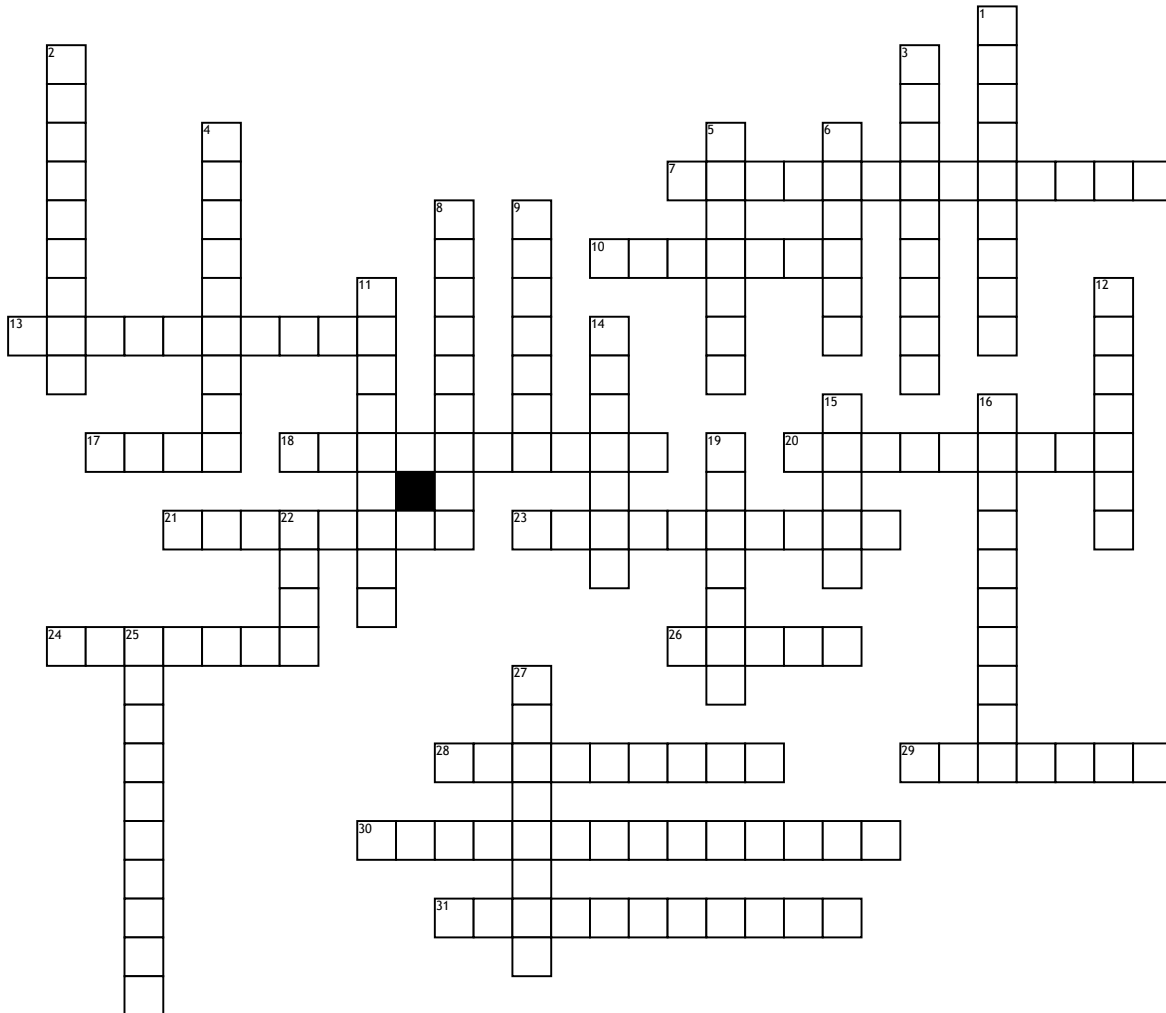


Mythological Allusions
