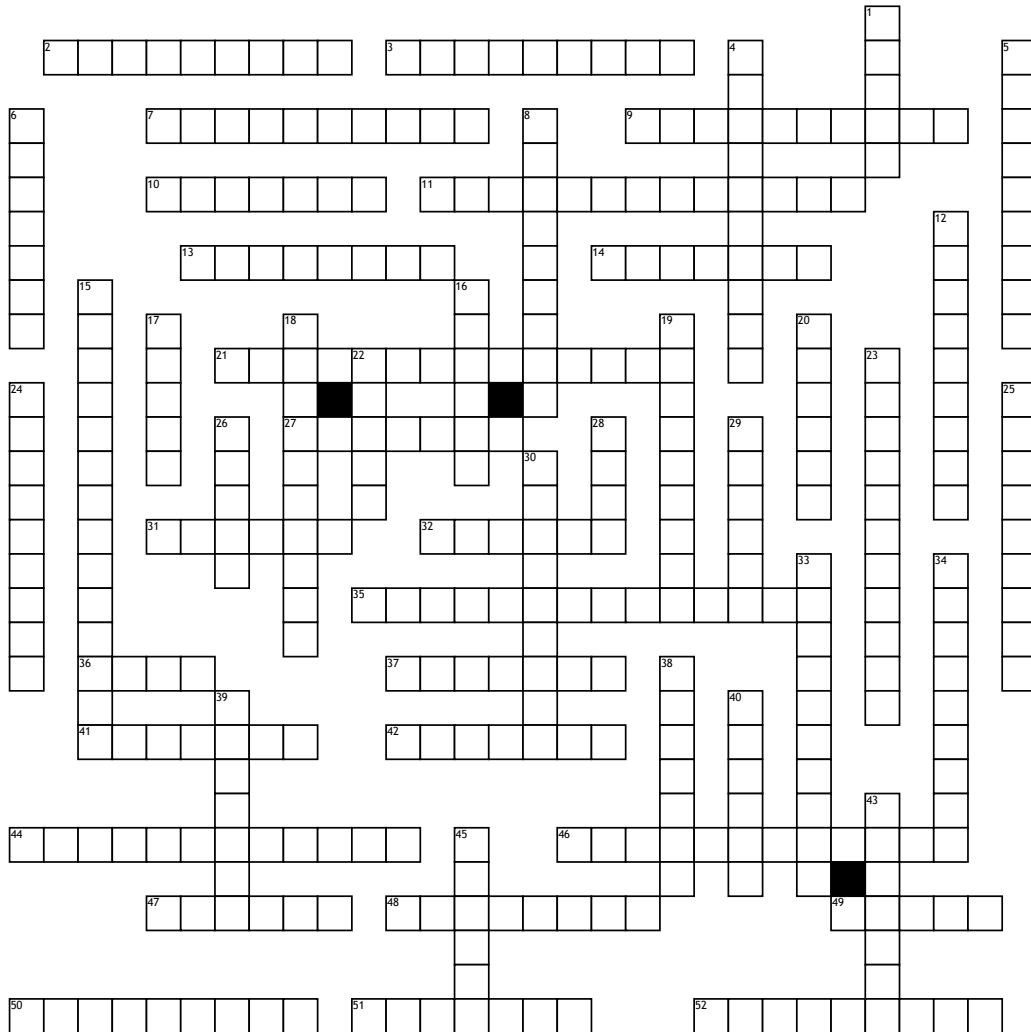


Mythological Allusions Crossword
