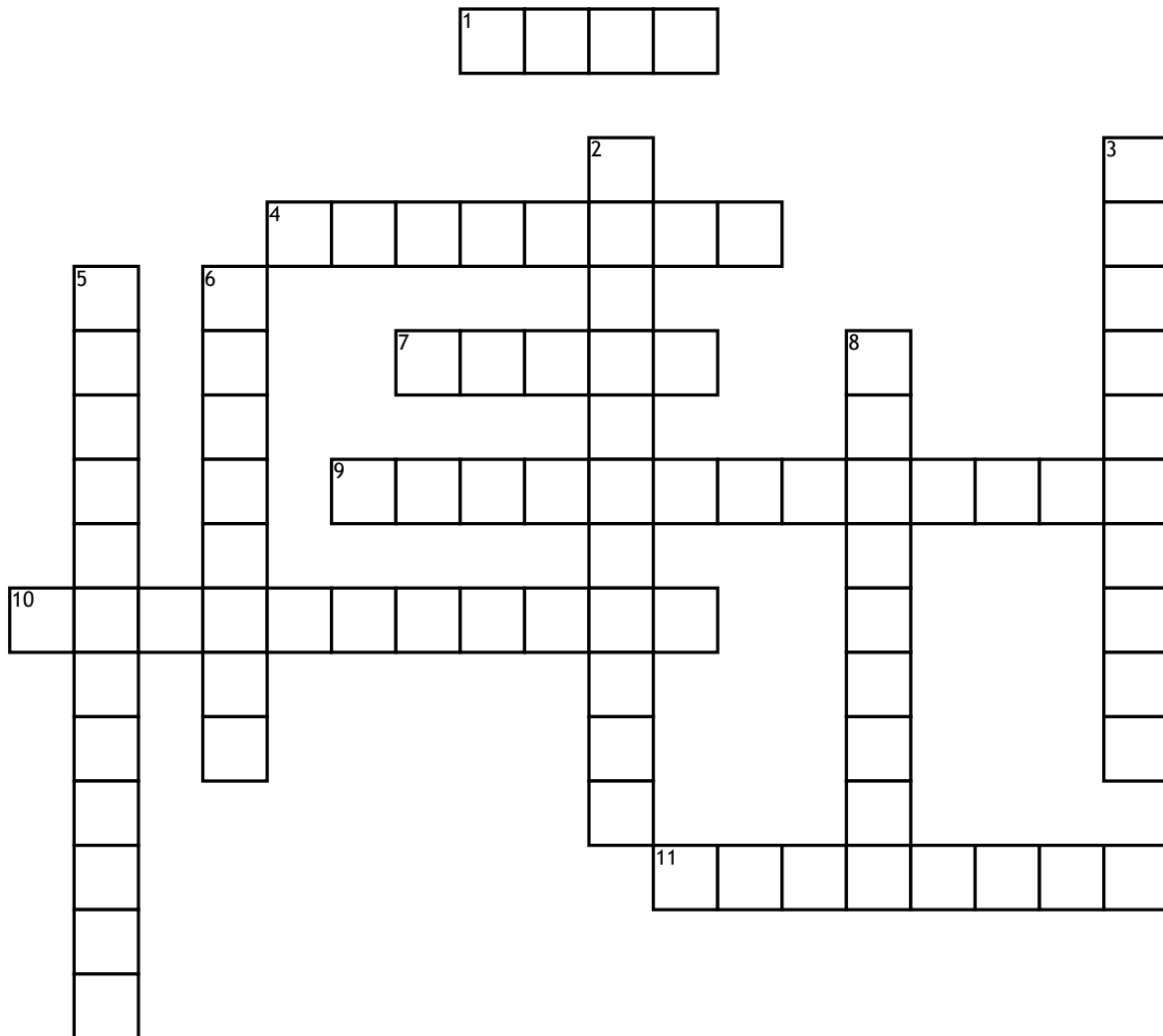

2. mandated the segregation of public facilities, including school, restaurants, bathrooms, and transportation
3. 14 year-old boy who was lynched, this lynching was a turning point of the Civil Rights Movement
5. one of the founders of the NAACP, was elected board chairmen in 1915 and president 1929-1939
6. a bill that punished those who participated or did not prosecute participants of Lynch mobs, was never passed by US Senate
8. W. E. B. Du Bois founded this official magazine of the NAACP
