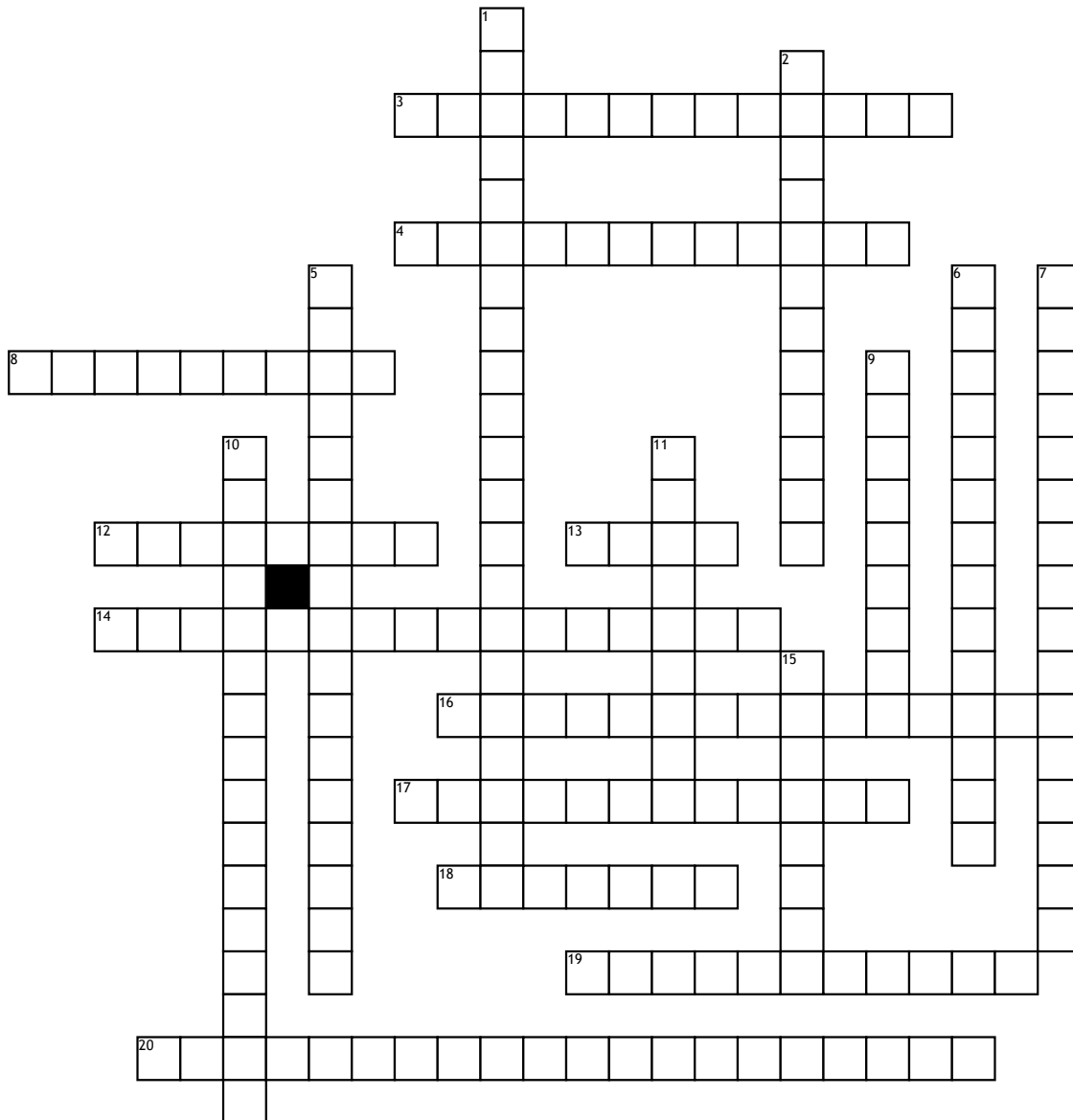

3. Risk factors that cannot be changed
 4. Caused by a disturbance in impulse formation or by conduction delays or blocks
 8. Heart failure: crackles, oliguria, confusion, cough
 12. Antidote for Opioids
 13. Immediate intervention if an IV site become infiltrated
 14. An emergency that causes compression of the heart caused by fluid collecting in the sac surrounding the heart

16. Drug used to decrease myocardial oxygen demand
 17. Most accurate assessment for fluid loss or gain
 18. Priority problem of Atrial Fibrillation
 19. Increases digoxin toxicity
 20. The most serious acute coronary syndrome

1. Localized edema, sudden onset of unilateral swelling, calf pain
 2. The most common side effect related to Angiotensin-Converting Enzyme Inhibitors

5. Identifies the location of cardiac ischemia and necrosis, related to myocardial infarction
 6. Primary treatment for Atrial Fibrillation
 7. Thickening or hardening of the arterial wall
 9. Common type of hypertension, no identified cause
 10. Must be checked by two qualified health care providers before administration
 11. Antidote of Heparin
 15. Occurs when blood flow to the heart is reduced
