

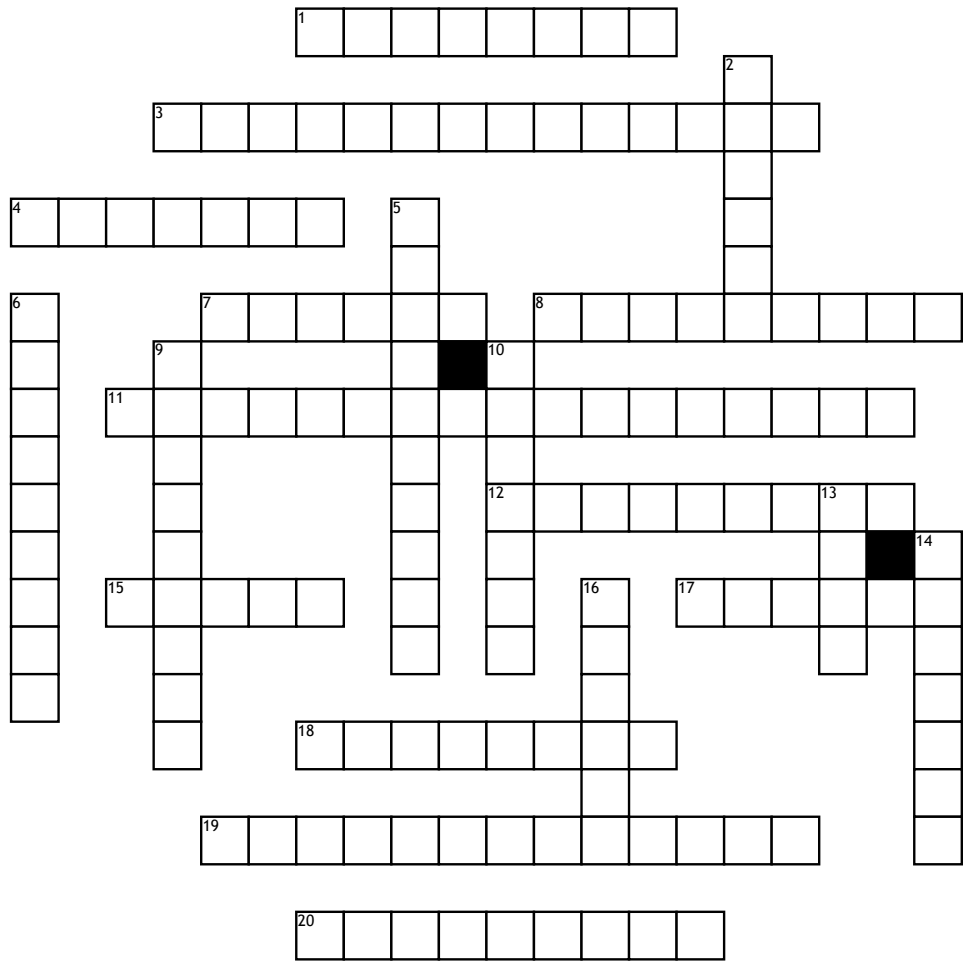
Name That Literary Genre!
