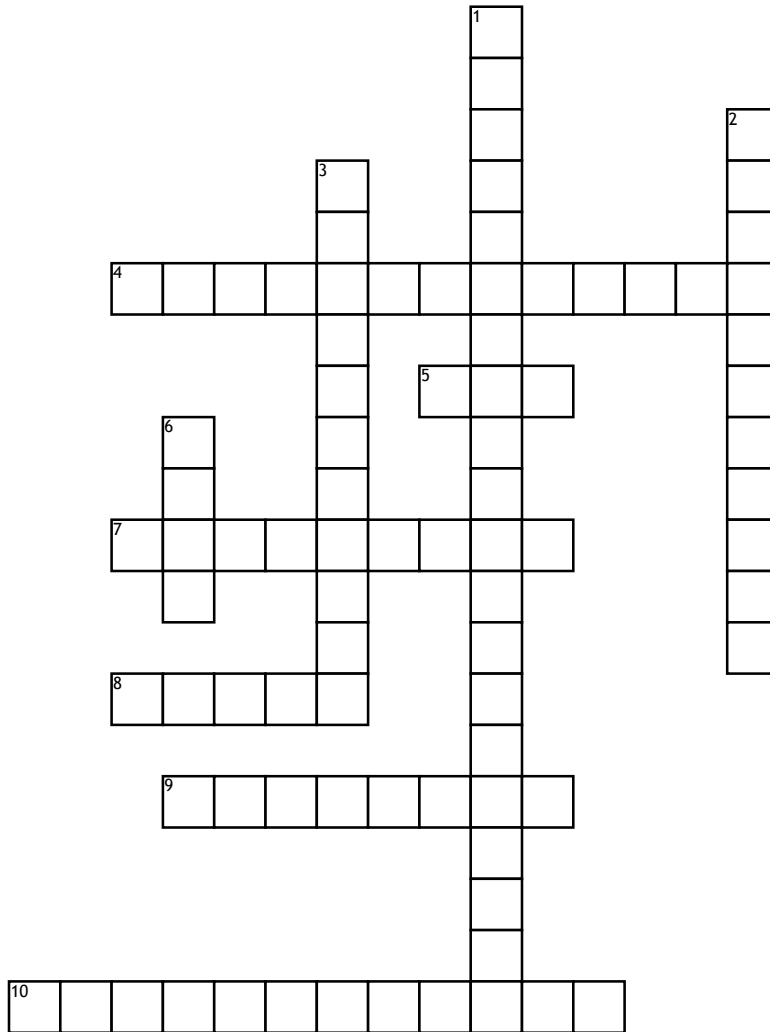

4. This task is used when the handler needs the dog to lay down from a distance. The dog must remain in the down until released.

5. This task is used to apply calming pressure during overstimulation or anxiety attacks.

7. This task is often used when the person drops an object. The dog is trained to pick the object up and place it in their persons hand.

8. This task is done with the dogs nose. It my provide sensory aid, disrupt behavior or provide stimulation.

9. This task often used when the dogs person needs help with balance.
