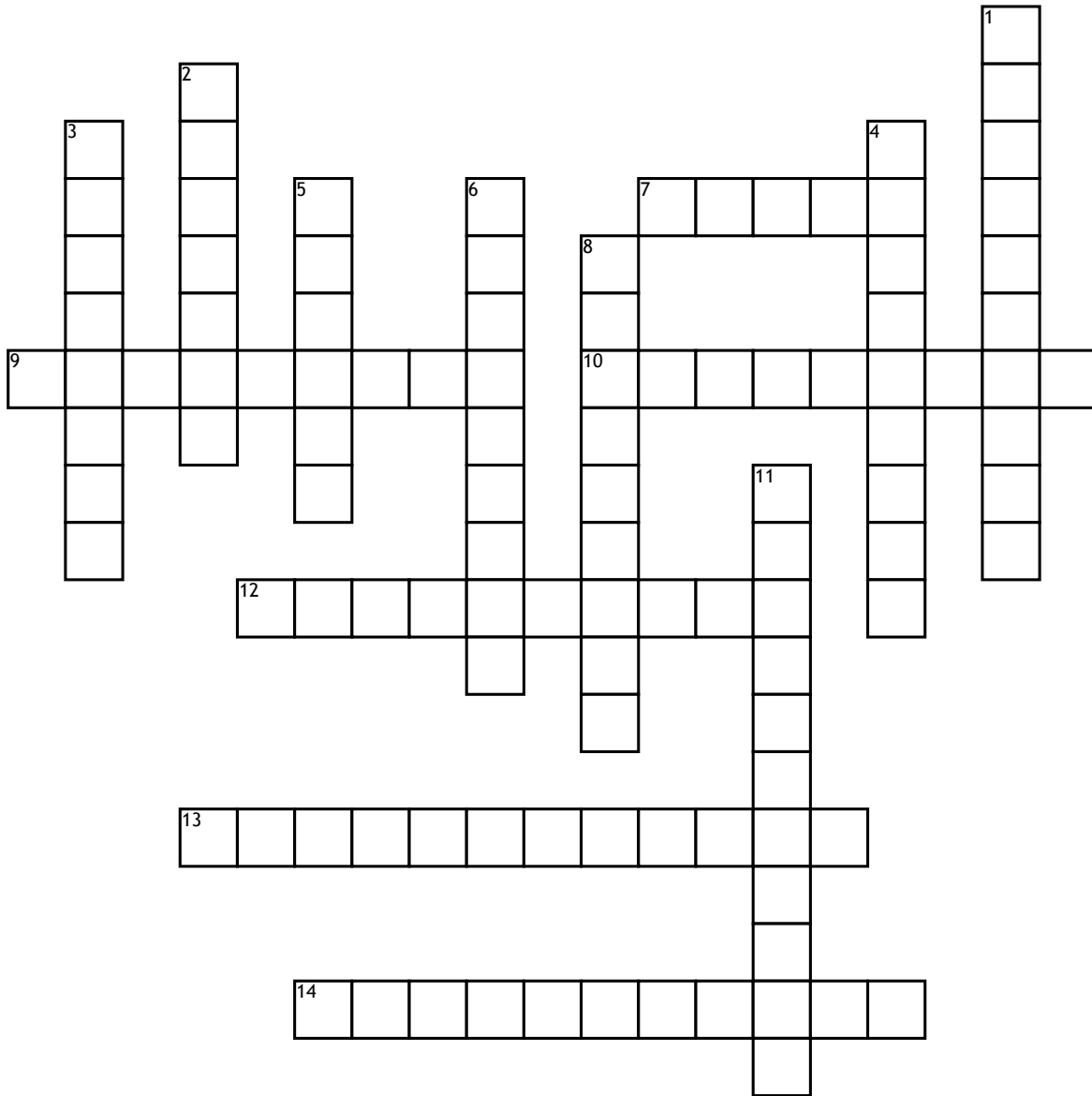


Name that park!

7. This park was established in 1895 through efforts by Philip Crapo. This park sits on 85 acres.
 9. This 4-acre park has three little league ball diamonds, play equipment, an open shelter and picnic amenities.
 10. This park is on N. 4th between Court and High Street. The land has been used for a public park since the original platting of the city.
 12. This 1.7 acre park was established in 1997 at the site of the elementary school at Marshall and Valley Streets.
 13. This is considered a 'pocket park' that sits on 1/2 an acre on Summer Street.

14. This is a memorial park on the corner of South 5th and Angular Streets named after these two influential people from the community. (DeEdwin and _____)

1. This is local landmark and originally designed to help horses scale the steep elevation change between Jefferson Street and The Heritage Hill District
 2. This park sits on 18 acres and was given to the city in 1927 to be used as a public park by Mr. Charles Elliot Perkins.
 3. This park is dated from the earliest days of the city overlooks the Mississippi River. It is located between N. 3rd and Franklin St.

4. This park was originally platted within city limits, and officially made 'a park for the use of the public' in 1836 along with North Hill Park.
 5. This is considered a 'pocket park' and is located in the 500 block of South Sixth Street.
 6. This park sits on the river front and offers a gazebo for visitors and will be linked with Flint River Trail.
 8. This park is considered our 'active park' and is located on 72 acres originally donated by Miss Lydia Dankwardt.
 11. This park is located downtown and dedicated in the memory of the first female mayor.
