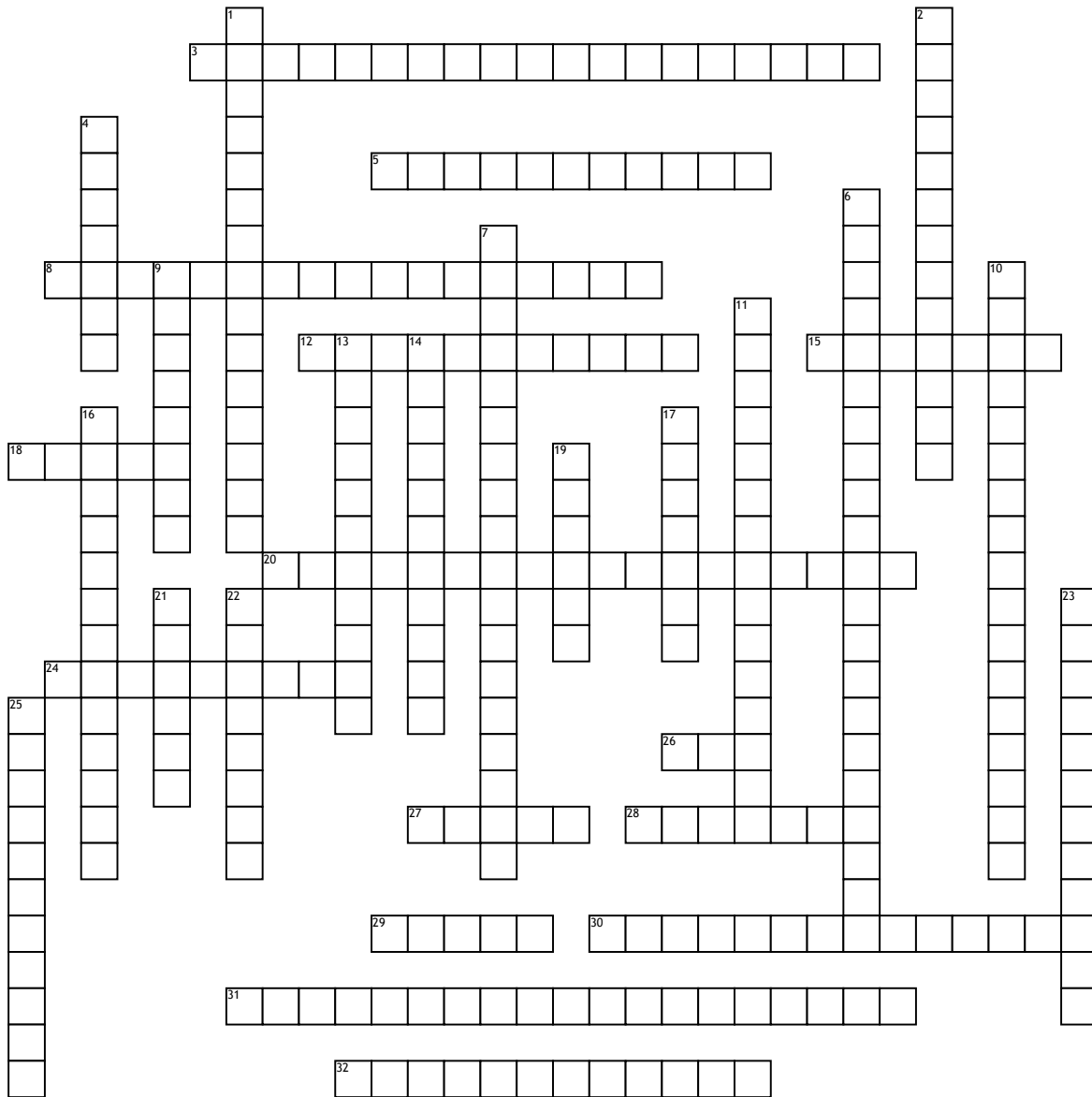


Nation's Social Studies Crossword Puzzle on Refugees and Water
