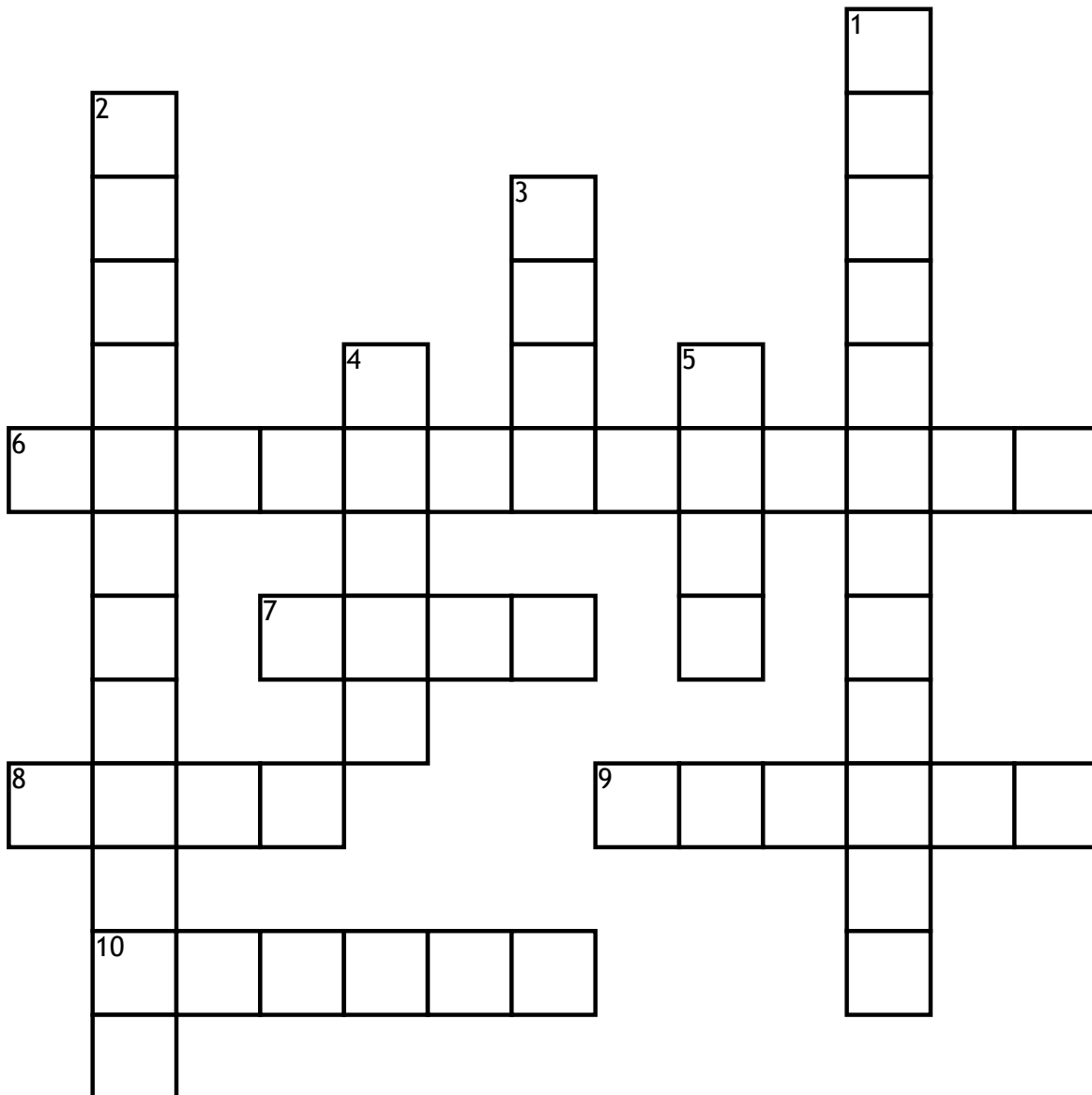

1. Fabric found in Inner Mongolia, China, Iran, Iraq, Turkey and Afghanistan and the earliest documented usage dates back to the 14th century.
2. Light or heavy in weight, depending on how it is spun
3. Produced from plants in the genus *Corchorus*.
4. Was invented by the Swiss chemist George Audemars in 1855.
5. Composed mainly of fibroin and is produced by certain insect larvae to form cocoons.
