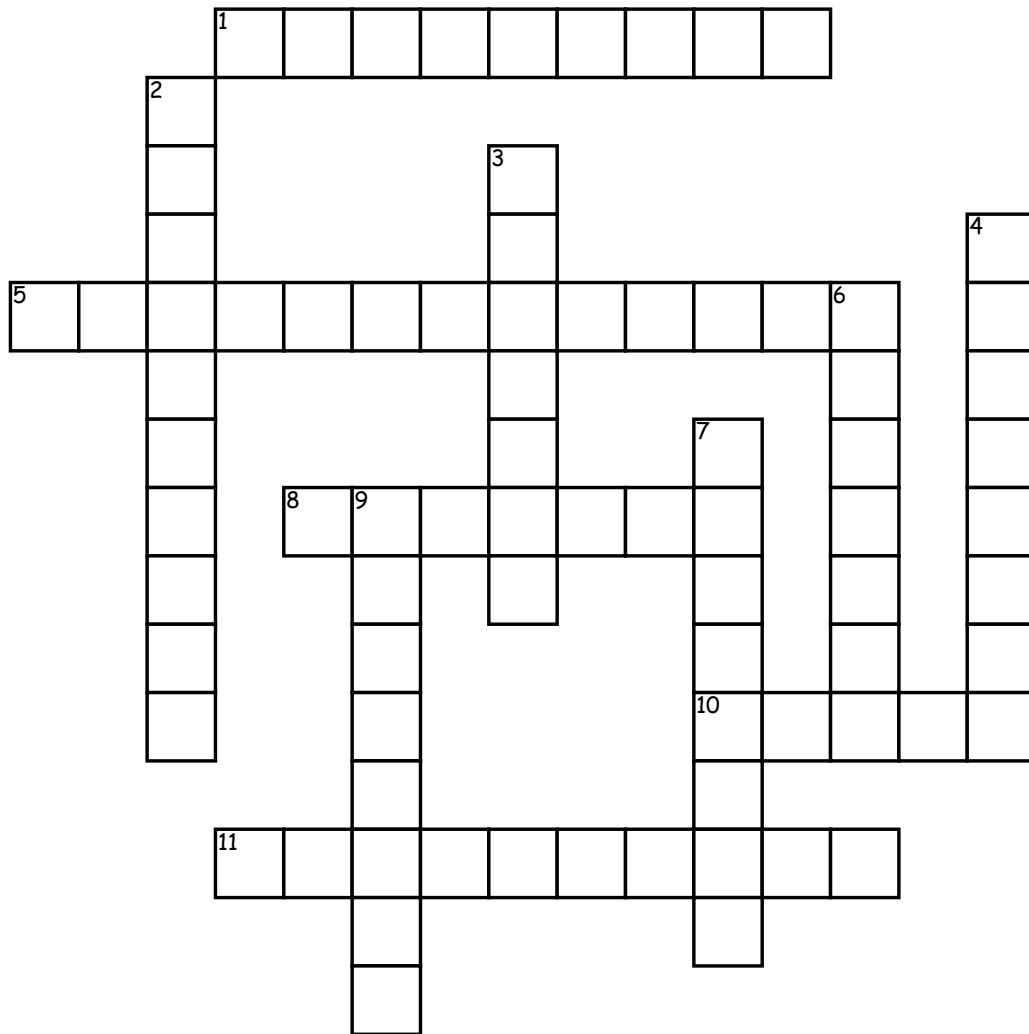


# Natural Hazards

- 2. Two blocks of Earth slip past one another creating a shaking of the ground

- 3. Formed when magma from within the Earth's upper mantle works its way to the surface
- 4. A severe snowstorm with high winds and low visibility
- 6. A violent rotating column of air extending from a thunderstorm to the ground
- 7. This needs the fire triangle: Oxygen, Fuel, and a Heat Source
- 9. A pit in the ground that forms because of erosion or underground water
