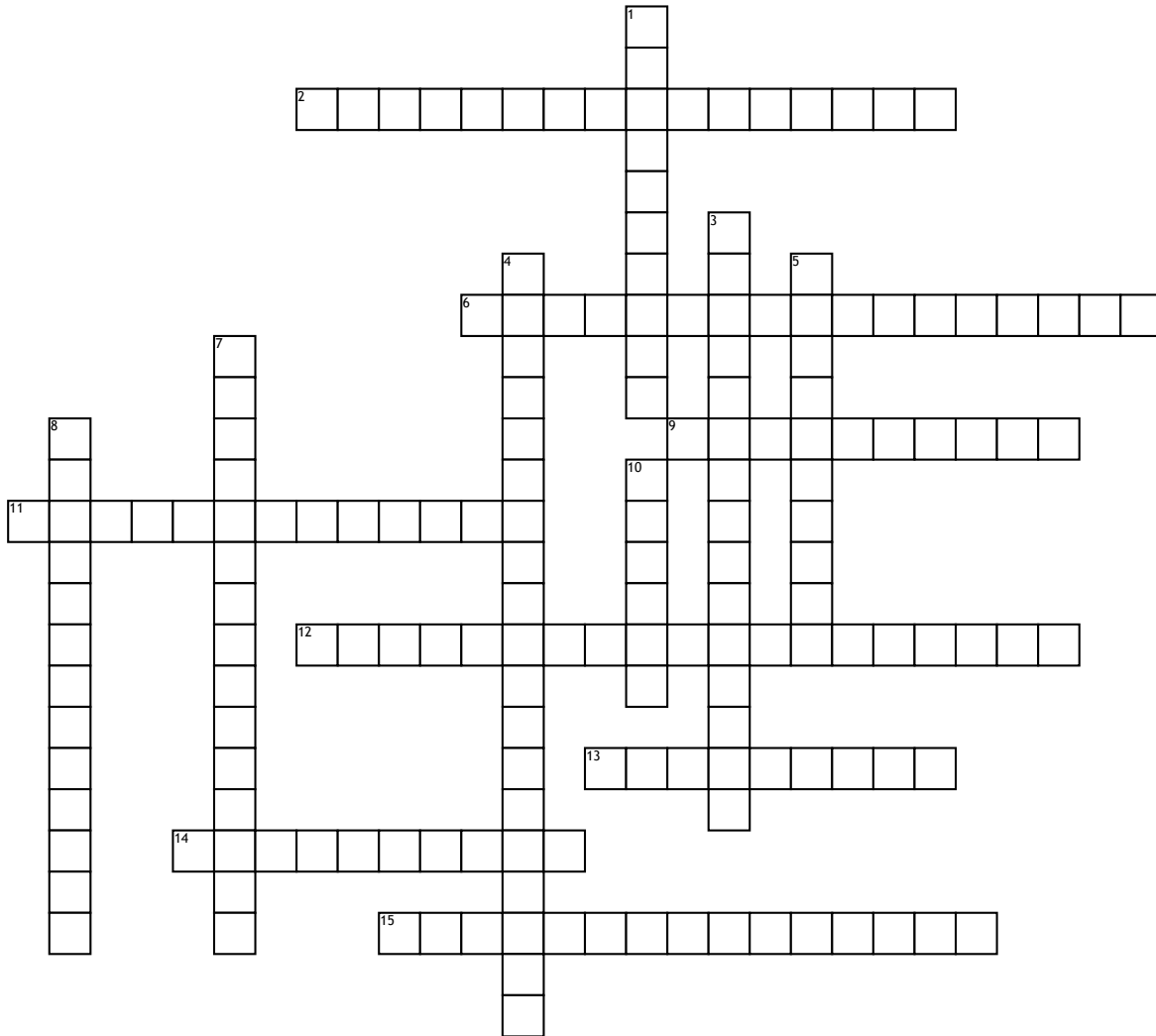

2. is a type of spina bifida. Spina bifida is a birth defect in which the spinal canal and the backbone don't close before the baby is born.

11. a rare neuroendocrine neoplasm that may develop at various body sites (including the head, neck, thorax and abdomen)
12. is a serious neurologic condition in which damage to the cauda equina causes loss of function of the lumbar plexus

14. Medical ultrasound is a diagnostic imaging technique based on the application of ultrasound.
