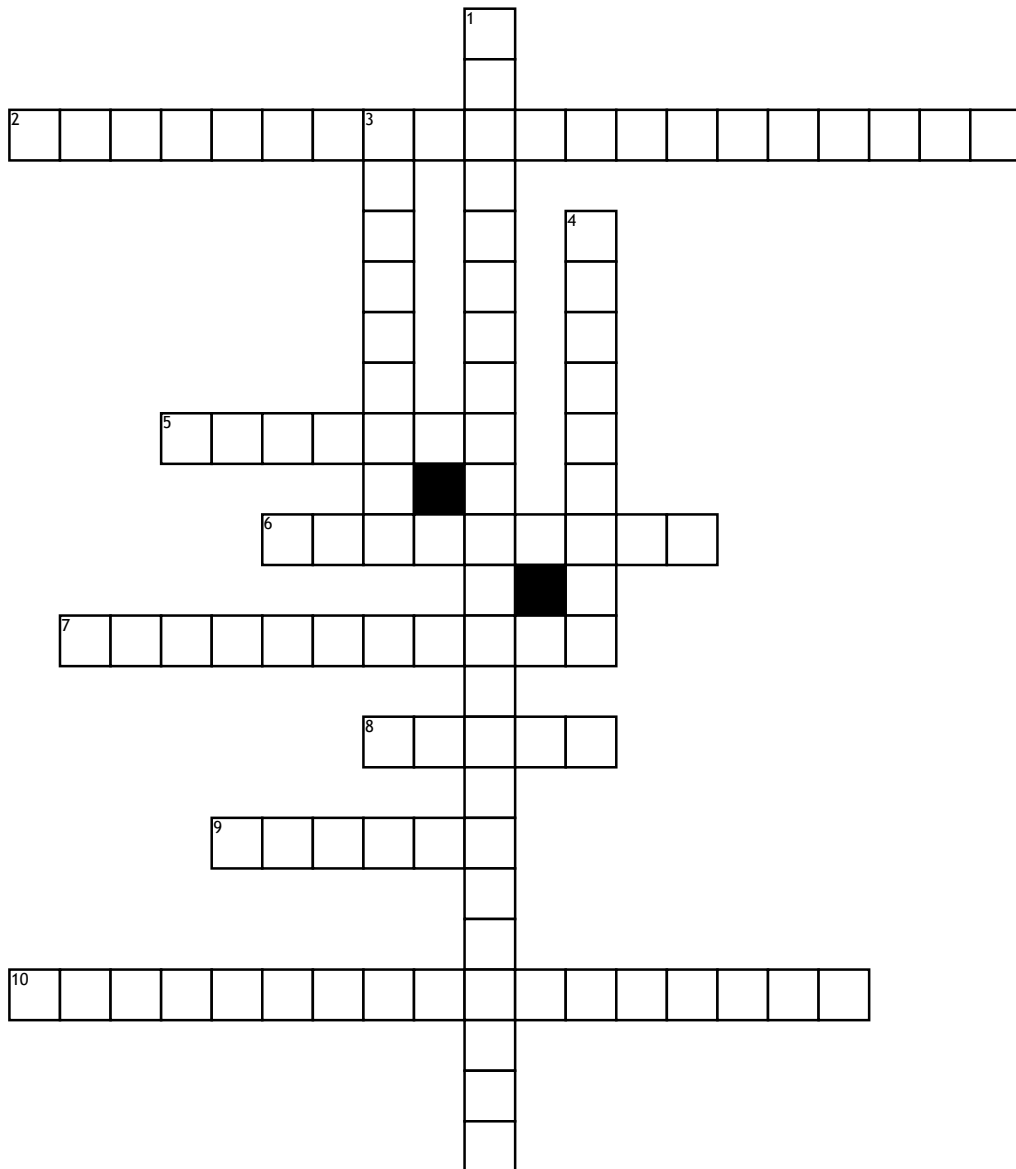


# Nervous System Crossword

2. CNS; consists of the spinal cord & brain

5. groups of nerve cell bodies lying outside the CNS

6. is located at the bottom of the brain where it joins the spinal cord

7. the brains has two of these that control the two sides of the brain

8. long nerve processes cary nerve impulses from the soma to other neurons; very in length but can be as long as half the body

9. a bundle of fibres (axons & dendrites) outside the CNS

10. are substances which excite or inhibit the neurons of the brain

1. PNS; is the nerves connected to the spinal cord

3. cells of the nervous system that help protect and support it

4. short, thick processes, branch out of the soma in a tree like manner
